

Get vaccinated today! COVID-19 vaccines are available for people age 12 and older.



COVID-19 vaccines are safe and effective, including against the new variants. The vaccines went through large clinical studies that showed they protect people from severe COVID-19 illness, hospitalization and death, and have been given safely to millions of people in the U.S.



COVID-19 vaccines are free. Insurance or sharing immigration status is not required.



To find a site to get vaccinated, visit nyc.gov/vaccinefinder, call 877-VAX-4NYC (877-829-4692), or scan the QR code below. No appointment is needed at many sites. For free in-home vaccination, visit nyc.gov/homevaccine or call 877-829-4692 .



You may experience some side effects, such as arm soreness, headache, body aches, tiredness and fever. Serious side effects are very rare.



Once fully vaccinated, you can do many activities without a face mask. However, we recommend you keep your mask on in all public indoor settings to protect others, including children under age 12 and people who are immunocompromised. Also, you must follow the mask requirements of any place you go, such as a business, school or workplace, or while using public transportation.
