Low- or No-Cost Health Insurance for Children



Child Health Plus (CHP) is a health insurance program that covers health care and dental needs for children. Coverage may be free or provided at a low cost depending on household size and income.

In many cases, children can get coverage regardless of immigration status.

Frequently Asked Questions About Child Health Plus (CHP)

Who can apply for CHP?

To qualify for CHP, the child must be:

- Under 19 years of age
- A resident of New York State

The child cannot

- Be eligible for Children's Medicaid
- Already have health insurance coverage

What benefits does CHP include?

- Regular checkups
- Dental care
- Immunizations
- Emergency care
- Hospital care
- Medicines
- X-ray and lab tests
- Vision care
- Speech and hearing services
- Medical equipment
- Specialty care

What is needed to apply?

To apply, you must include:

- Government ID
- Hospital or clinic records
- School information
- Passports

How can I apply?
