Saving Lives with Naloxone

What Providers Need to Know

**Anyone can reverse
an opioid overdose
with naloxone.**

**Prescribe naloxone to your patients
with these risk factors:**

- 1. Opioid misuse/illicit use**
- 2. Decreased tolerance after a period of abstinence**
- 3. High-dose opioid prescription (≥ 100 total morphine milligram equivalents/day)**
- 4. Chronic opioid therapy**

**Patients, friends and family
members can also obtain free
naloxone from the programs
on the reverse of this card.**
