

## 2019 Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) SurvEpi Branch Daily Data Summary

March 17, 2020

The total number of positive cases in the city are updated continuously, so this data may not be currently accurate. It reflects the case count as of 6 p.m. the day before they are posted. Due to public health guidance that people with mild illness stay home, these data may not reflect the true number of positive COVID-19 cases in NYC and may overrepresent the volume of hospitalized cases.
