Fentanyl may be in the cocaine you are using, buying, or selling.

SAFETY TIPS:



USE WITH OTHERS. If you overdose, it's important to have someone around to help.



CARRY NALOXONE/NARCAN®, a medication that can reverse an overdose involving heroin, fentanyl, or other painkillers. Have it on hand and tell others how to use it. It could save your life.
