


# Recent West Nile Virus Activity\* in New York City, by Zip Code, July 4 to July 29, 2010

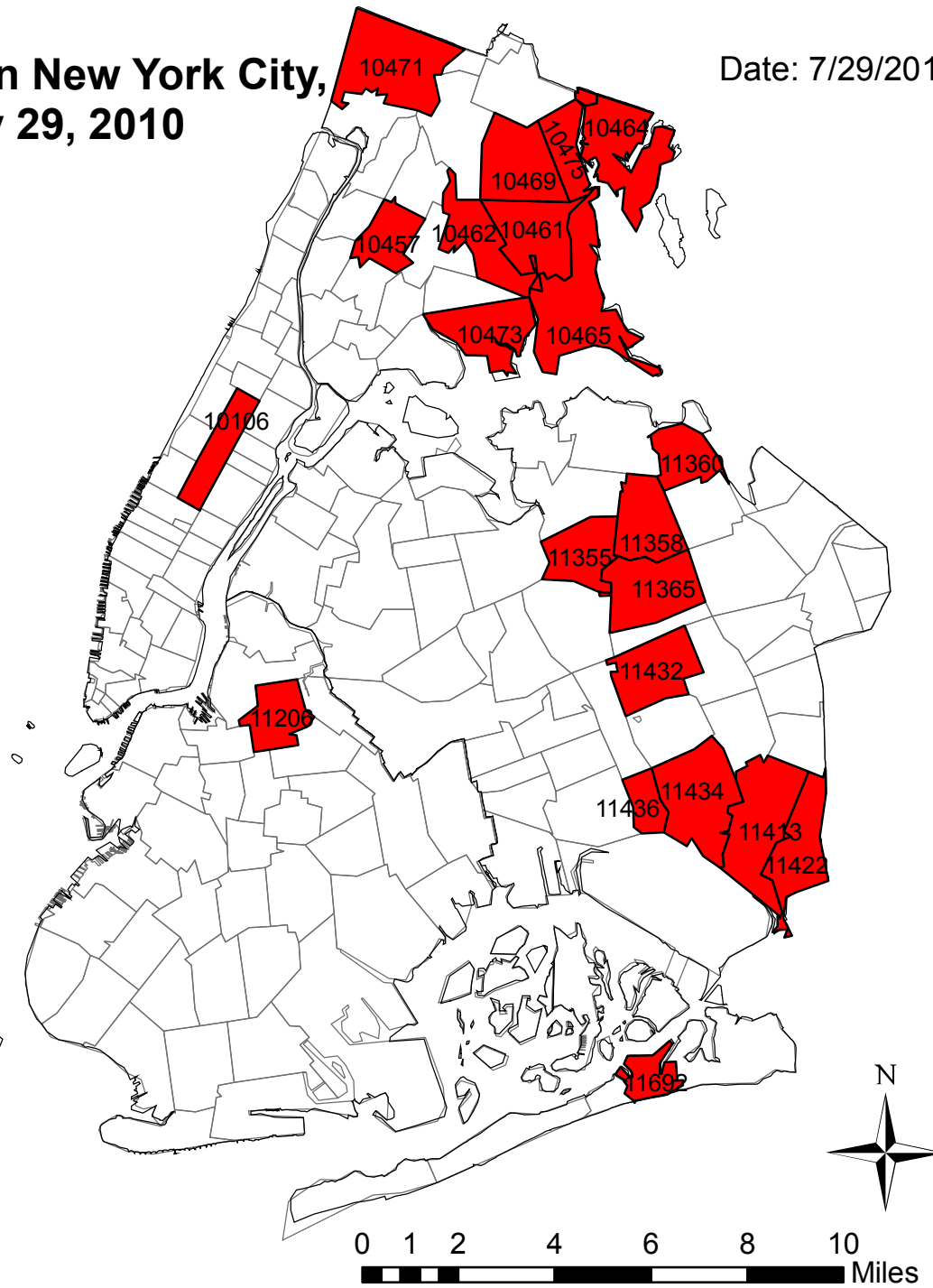
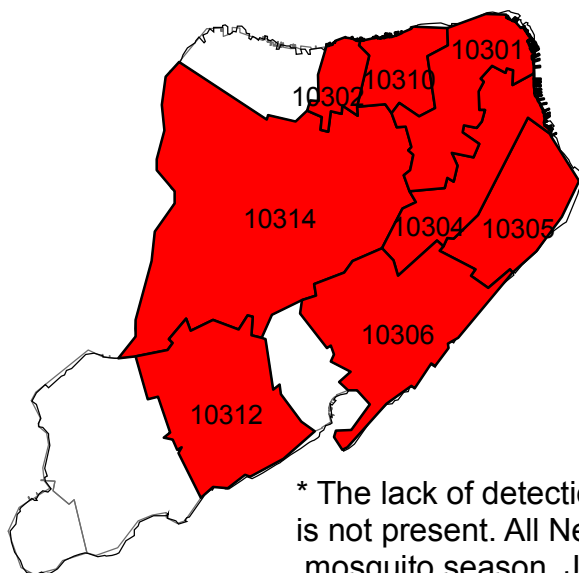
