Intern Description

In addition, for positions that have a law enforcement and/or investigative function, the candidate's consumer credit history will be reviewed during the background investigation, and as otherwise permitted by NYC Administrative Code § 8-107(24)(b)(2)(A)

- Help with OS and Application patching
- Understand Security Frame works. Particularly, ISO-27001

 - Ability to maintain confidentiality while dealing with sensitive information
 - Basic knowledge of Cryptography
- Familiarity with Windows 10 Professional, Linux, and scripting languages such as Powershell, Javascript, Python or Go talking to APIs is a plus
