**COMMISSIONER MARK G. PETER'S STATEMENT ON CONFLICT OF INTEREST BOARD SETTLEMENTS  
WITH NEW YORK CITY BOARD OF ELECTIONS OFFICIALS**

"As DOI's investigations and reports have demonstrated several times, the Board of Elections has serious problems that remain unaddressed, including the need for public job postings and a specific anti-nepotism policy. The imposition of the maximum legal fine on the Board's President should send a powerful message that this conduct will not be tolerated."

The agency investigates and refers for prosecution City employees and contractors engaged in corrupt or fraudulent activities or unethical conduct.
