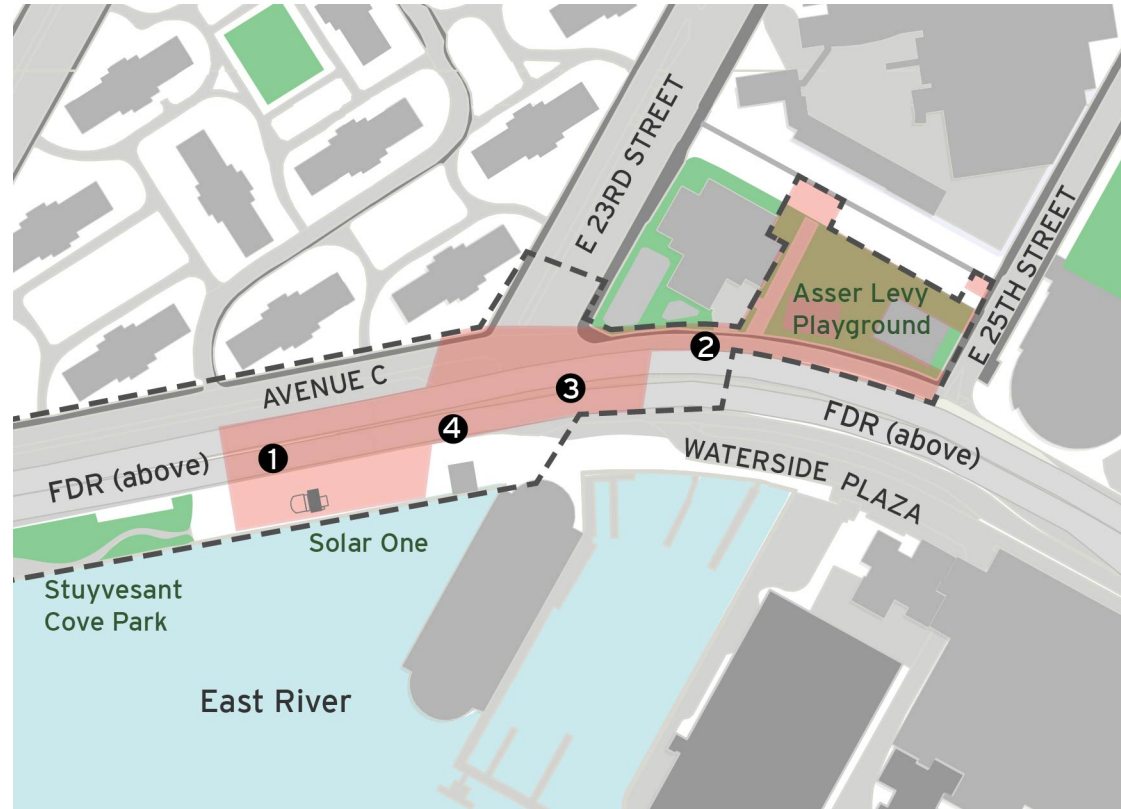

1	03/29/21-04/09/21	7:00 am to 3:30 pm	Adjacent to Solar One	Greenway closed. Remove "abandoned" ConEd Electric Ducts & cut ConEd Oil-O-Static Lines. Excavate for sewer box and sewer manhole. Prep work for wall foundation. Begin daytime pile driving work.
2	03/29/21-04/09/21	10:00 pm to 5:00 am	FDR Dr. West Service Rd. Between E. 23rd Street & E 25th Street	Night work for at least the next 3 weeks: Utility relocation ongoing. Install sewer and sewer manhole and 12" watermain – No service interruption anticipated by the watermain work.
3	03/29/21-04/09/21	7:00 am to 3:30 pm	E 23rd Street underneath the FDR Dr.	Traffic Pattern will continue under the FDR Dr. Utility work ongoing in preparation for flood wall installation. Installation of sewer manhole and 24" sewer and Catch basin.
4	03/29/21-04/09/21	7:00 am to 3:30 pm	FDR Dr. East Service Road adjacent to BP gas station	*Change in Traffic Pattern: shift to the north side – Monday 3/29 Remove & install catch basin, 12" sewer & sewer manhole. Utility relocation.
