

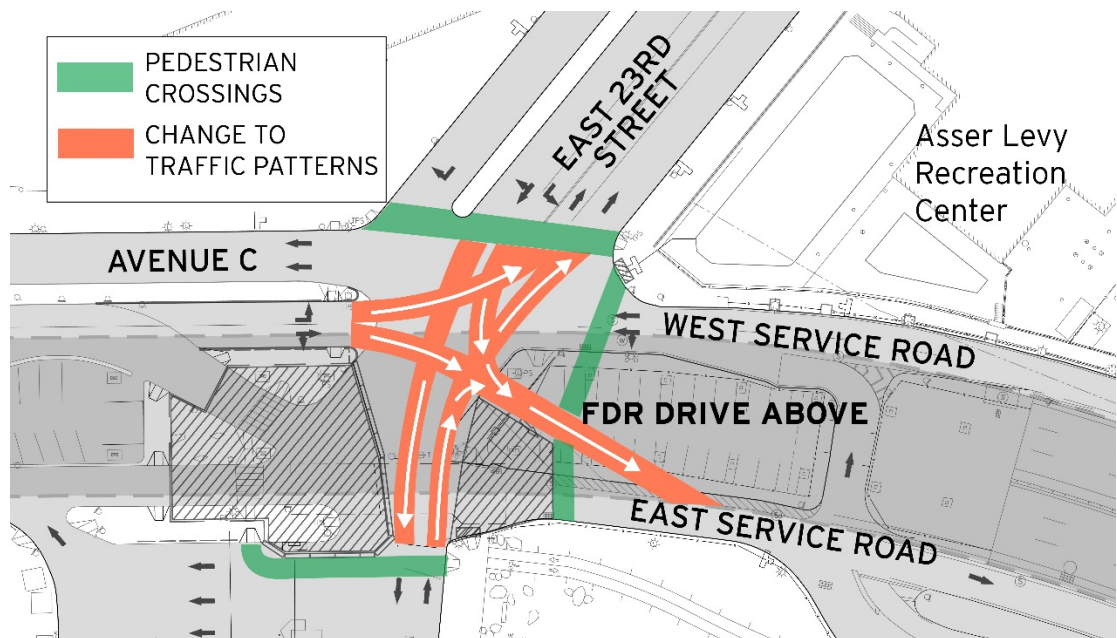

South Side Crosswalk Closure @ E 23rd St. under FDR Dr.

Begins the week of June 14, 2021, for approximately eight (8) weeks

To facilitate the construction of the floodwall, the crosswalk on the south side at E. 23rd St. underneath the FDR Dr. will be temporarily closed. This area is adjacent to the BP Gas Station. Pedestrians may use the newly reopened northside crosswalk.
