A child support order is a court-ordered contribution to be paid by a parent to assist with the living and medical expenses of a child until a child becomes a legal adult.

The Family Court Division of the New York City Law Department provides services to local custodial parents for child support matters through the Interstate Child Support Unit.

The Interstate Child Support Unit staff can assist custodial parents with interstate child support matters in order to obtain or enforce a child support order.

The Interstate Child Support Unit has offices in all five boroughs.



REQUESTING A REFERRAL TO THE LAW DEPARTMENT
