Alternative Issuance Procedure (AIP) Information for G-99

This document provides the procedures to follow in order to obtain a **Certificate of Fitness for Use of Anhydrous Ammonia for Heat Treating (Dissociators) and Duplicating Machines (G-99)**, without a written exam administered by the New York City Fire Department.

Application for AIP must be submitted by mail. If the application meets all requirements, a Certificate of Fitness will be sent to the applicant's or company's mailing address within five business days.

Applicants must understand that the Fire Department reserves the right to randomly call up to exam the applicants who are issued by AIP. Applicant who has failed the written exam will not be allowed to take advantage of this policy.

1. How to Apply:

If you meet the requirements below you can submit an application(s):

(a) Individually or (b) through FDNY approved employer's designated coordinator.

- a. An individual applicant can submit his/her own application. *(If you are an individual, you can only submit your own application.)* **OR**
- b. A designated coordinator (DC) can submit application(s) on behalf of the company's employees. The company's authorized DC must be approved by FDNY. To request approval, email to arayae@fdny.nyc.gov

2. Qualification Requirements: *(applicants must submit all supporting requirements by mail.)*

2.1. Education, License and Experience Requirements

Applicants must have one of the following qualifications:

- A Refrigeration license issued by the New York City Fire Department And A certificate of Fitness for Boiler
- A license as a Certified Industrial Hygienist (AIHA)
- A license as a Certified Safety Professional (ASSE)
- Bachelor's degree in Chemistry, Chemical Engineering, or related field and **TWO** years of experience supervising the use of anhydrous ammonia for heat treating (dissociators) and duplicating machines

(Degree issued from outside USA or is not in English shall be evaluated by an independent evaluation service accepted by NYC Fire Department.)

2.3. **Photo**

A recent photo (2x2 head shot) in JPG or JPEG format.

2.4. **Application Fee**

The application fee for **G-99** is \$ **25**. The following payment methods are acceptable:

- Personal (made payable to the New York City Fire Department)
- company check (made payable to the New York City Fire Department)
- money order (made payable to the New York City Fire Department)

For fee waivers please submit: *(Only government employees who will use their C of F for their work-related Responsibilities are eligible for fee waivers.)*

- An agency letter with official letter head; **AND**
- Copy of identification card issued by the agency

A convenience fee of 2.49% will be applied to all credit card payments.

3. **Renewal Information**

FDNY also reserves the right to require the applicants to take a re-examination upon submission of the renewal application. This Certificate of Fitness must be renewed every **THREE YEARS**.
