Alternative Issuance Procedure (AIP) Information for S-95

This document provides the procedures to follow in order to obtain a **Certificate of Fitness for Supervision of Fire Alarm Systems and Other Related Systems (S-95)** without a written exam administered by the New York City Fire Department.

Application for AIP must be submitted **online**. If the application meets all requirements, a Certificate of Fitness will be sent to the applicant's/company's mailing address within five business days.

Applicants must understand that the Fire Department reserves the right to randomly call up to exam the applicants who are issued by AIP. Applicant who has failed the written exam will not be allowed to take advantage of this policy.

1. How to Apply:

If you meet the requirements below you can submit an application(s) electronically online through NYC Business Express - <https://www1.nyc.gov/nycbusiness/description/cof-s95/apply> : (a) individually or (b) through FDNY approved employer's designated coordinator:

- a. An individual applicant can submit his/her own application. *(If you are an individual, you can only submit your own application.)*
- b. A designated coordinator (DC) can submit application(s) on behalf of the company's employees. The company's authorized DC must be approved by FDNY. To request approval, email to arayae@fdny.nyc.gov

2. Qualification Requirements: *(applicants must submit all supporting requirements electronically online)*

2.1. Education, License and Experience Requirements

Applicants must have one of the following qualifications:

- A New York State license to install, repair and maintain fire alarm systems
- A Certificate of Fitness for Fire Alarm Systems Inspection, Testing and Service Technician (S-97/ S-98)
- A Certificate of Fitness for Inspection, Cleaning and Testing of Smoke Detectors (S-78 / F-78)

(Degree issued from outside USA or is not in English shall be evaluated by an independent evaluation service accepted by NYC Fire Department.)

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2.3. Photo

A recent photo (2x2 head shot) in JPG or JPEG format.

2.4. Application Fee

The application fee for **S-95** is **\$ 25**. The following payment methods are acceptable:

- Credit Card (American Express, Discover, MasterCard, or Visa)
- Debit card (MasterCard or Visa)
- E-Check

For fee waivers please submit: *(Only government employees who will use their C of F for their work-related responsibilities are eligible for fee waivers.)*

- An agency letter with official letter head; **AND**
- Copy of identification card issued by the agency
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A convenience fee of 2.49% will be applied to all credit card payments.

3. Renewal Information

FDNY also reserves the right to require the applicants to take a re-examination upon submission of the renewal application. This Certificate of Fitness must be renewed every **THREE YEARS**. The renewal fee is **\$15**. The certificate can be renewed on-line, by mail or in person. For more detail renewal information, review **S-95** Notice of Exam:
