MEDICAL EXAMINATION FAQS – PART 12

CHEST X-RAY STATION

- Q-1: What is tested at the Chest X-Ray station?
- A-1: At this station your chest will be x-rayed to test for problems with your heart, lungs, and spine.
- Q-2: What are some test results that may require further evaluation?
- A-2: Among other results, the following may require further evaluation:
 - Evidence of pulmonary disease;
 - Enlarged heart;
 - Severe scoliosis; and
 - Use of a heart pacemaker that was not previously disclosed.
- Q-3: If I am pregnant, am I required complete the Chest X-Ray station?
- A-3: X-rays are not administered to pregnant women. Candidates will be asked to sign a consent form confirming the candidate is not pregnant before undergoing any x-rays. We strongly recommend that you discuss the FDNY medical exam with your OB/GYN.
