NOTICE OF RULEMAKING

Pursuant to the power vested in me as Commissioner of Finance by sections 389(b) and 1043 of the New York City Charter, section 237 of the Vehicle and Traffic Law and section 19-203 of the Administrative Code of the City of New York, I hereby promulgate the within amendment to the Rules Relating to Parking Violations. This amendment was published in proposed form on June 1, 2009. A hearing for public comment was held on July 2, 2009.

Rules Relating to Parking Violations

Section 1. A new subdivision (n) is added to section 39-03 of Chapter 19 of the Rules of the City of New York (Rules Relating to Parking Violations) to read as follows:

(n) Fee for Fleet Program Enrollment. The annual non-refundable fee for enrollment in the Fleet Program is \$1.50 per plate.

BASIS AND PURPOSE OF AMENDMENT

A company with one or more vehicles registered or leased under the company's name and address is eligible to enroll in the Department of Finance Fleet Program, which provides enrolled companies with a method to organize and keep track of parking violations incurred for their vehicles. Under this program, the Department issues weekly reports to enrolled companies listing parking tickets issued to license plates enrolled in the program. The enrolled companies are then given a penalty-free period to address those violations. This rule amendment imposes an annual fee of \$1.50 for each license plate enrolled in the Fleet Program in order to offset the administrative costs incurred by the Department of Finance in operating the program.
