Notes from Frances Pardus-Abbadessa, Executive Deputy Commissioner HRA/OCSE:

Total collections received for the month of July (four week month) was \$55,405,826. Calendar year 2014 to date collections for NYC total \$433,104,642. SEP is stable at 71.4% and PEP remains high at 76.95%. 41% of our account level cases received a collection in the month. However, if we consider only actively charging cases (cases with an ongoing obligation) the percentage of total cases with a collection increases to 58% for this month.

⁽¹⁾ This measure includes actively charging and arrears only cases.

⁽²⁾ We continue to observe the effects of ongoing cleanup projects aiming at closing account level cases that are appropriate for closure. This contributes to the large decrease in Current Support Due and in the percentage of "Current Distributed - Former."

⁽³⁾ The State carried out a one-time clean up project in 2012 with the Department of Health to identify cases that received Medicaid at any time and moved the collection data from Never to Former, leaving the cases in place.
