### Notes from Frances Pardus-Abbadessa, Executive Deputy Commissioner HRA/OCSE:

OCSE collected \$68,094,476 in August, the second highest collection for a five week month in CY 2014. Calendar year to date collections have reached \$501.2 million. Support establishment (SEP) remains stable at 71.34%, and paternity establishment (PEP) attained its highest level to date reaching 77.06% (2014 Goal - 76%). New orders year to date are at 14,561 which is a 13.4 % increase over the same period (Jan-Aug) last year. The percent of cases with a collection increased by 1%, increasing from 118,026 in July to 120,691 in August, which means more families are receiving their child support.

<sup>(1)</sup> This measure includes actively charging and arrears only cases. However, if we consider only actively charging cases (cases with an ongoing obligation) the Total Cases with a Collection percentage remains stable at 59% this month.

<sup>(2)</sup> We continue to observe the effects of ongoing cleanup projects aiming at closing account level cases that are appropriate for closure. This contributes to the large decrease in Current Support Due and in the percentage of "Current Distributed – Former."

<sup>(3)</sup> The State carried out a one-time clean up project in 2012 with the Department of Health to identify cases that received Medicaid at any time and moved the collection data from Never to Former, leaving the cases in place.
