IDNYC Mobile Enrollment Center Visits NYCFC Soccer Home Opener

IDNYC is on the road with the debut of the program's new Mobile Command Center, "IDNYC On-the-Go!" which made its first stop at the NYCFC soccer team's home opener at Yankee Stadium on Sunday, March 12. Commissioner Banks, who is also an NYCFC season ticket holder, was able to stop by and visit the mobile enrollment team before the match.

IDNYC On-the-Go! has the ability to process 40 to 60 applications a day, and doubles as a response vehicle

during emergencies, with a generator and power systems for use during a natural disaster. The next stop for the mobile enrollment center was the Edenwald Houses in the Bronx, where the IDNYC team took applications from March 21-24. The IDNYC On-the-Go! Van will be back at Edenwald Houses from Monday, April 3 through Friday, April 7, 10:20am-3:40pm. Anyone is welcome to apply at the mobile center, whether or not they live in NYCHA housing.

IDNYC is the free identification card for all New York City residents. It is an accepted form of ID at all City locations, it serves as a library card, it includes one year of free membership in 40 of the city's top museums and cultural institutions, and it comes with a wide variety of other benefits and discounts.
