WHAT TO EXPECT:

1

INTAKE INTERVIEW

A caseworker will contact you to gather information for your child support case.

2

MEET WITH CUSTOMER SERVICES

Child Support staff will contact both parents, help them obtain the required documents, and draw up the Stipulation Agreement based on the same guidelines the Family Court uses.

3

ATTEND THE COURT HEARING

The Family Court will review the Stipulation Agreement and make sure you understand your legal rights. The Court will issue an Order of Support. Child support collection can begin.
