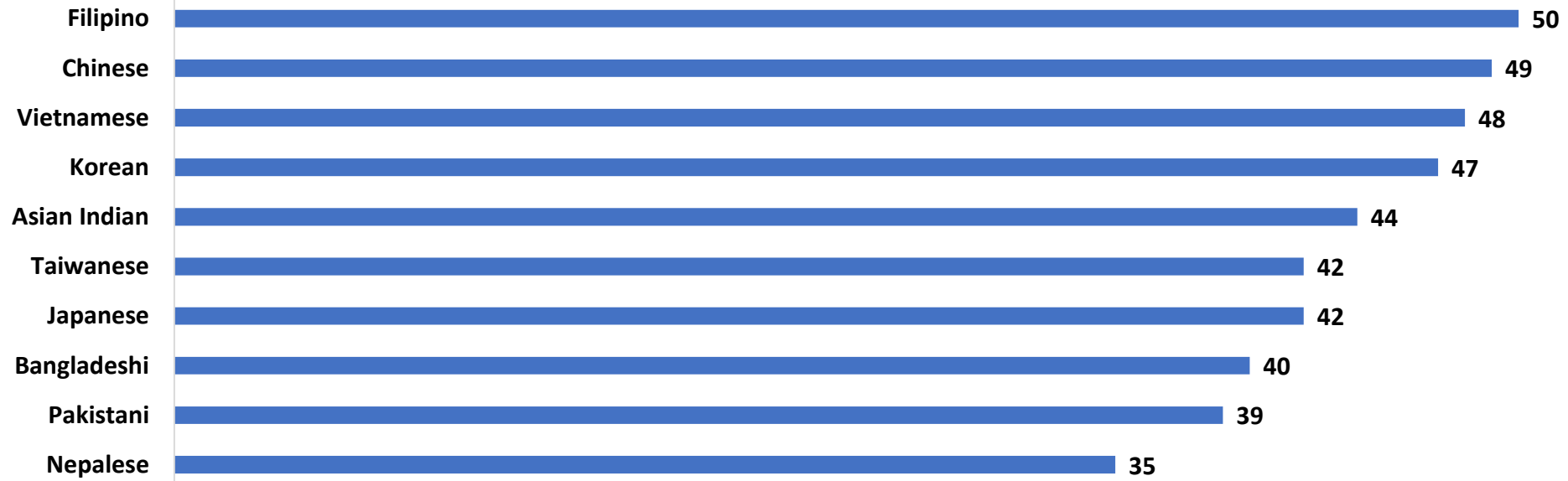

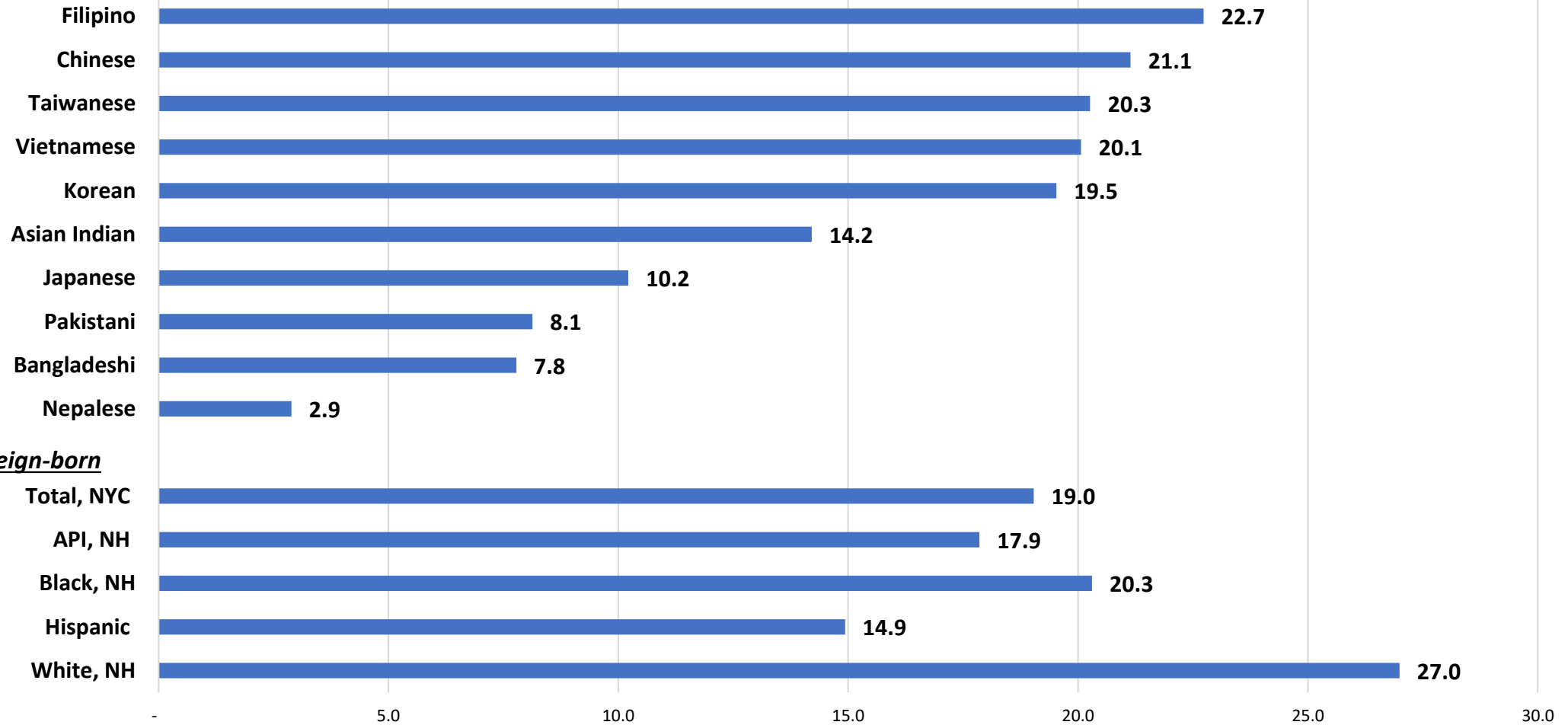

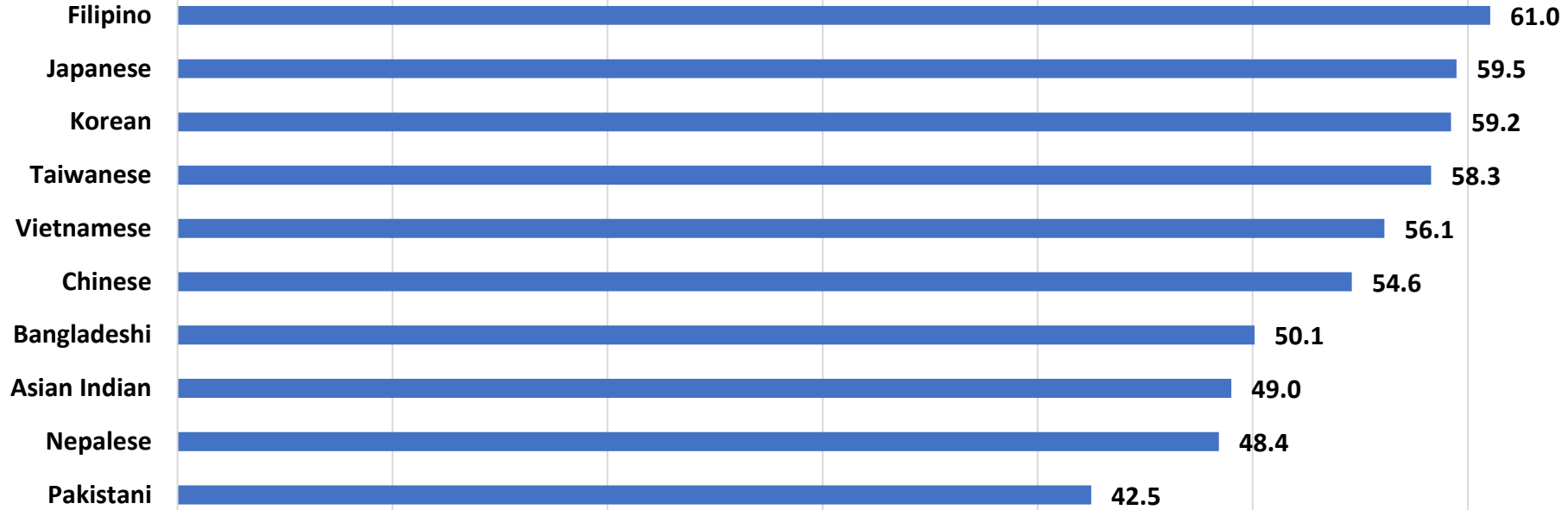

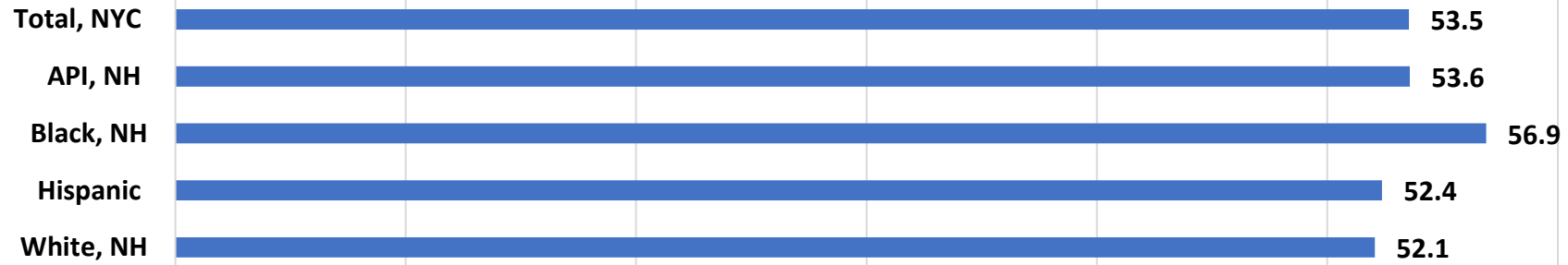

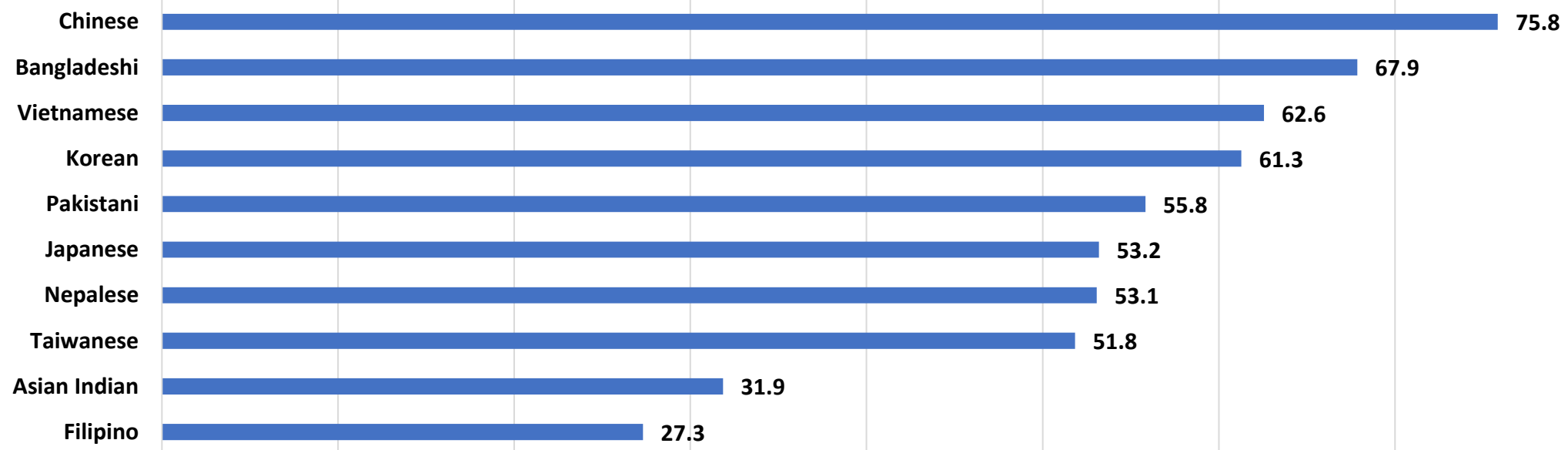

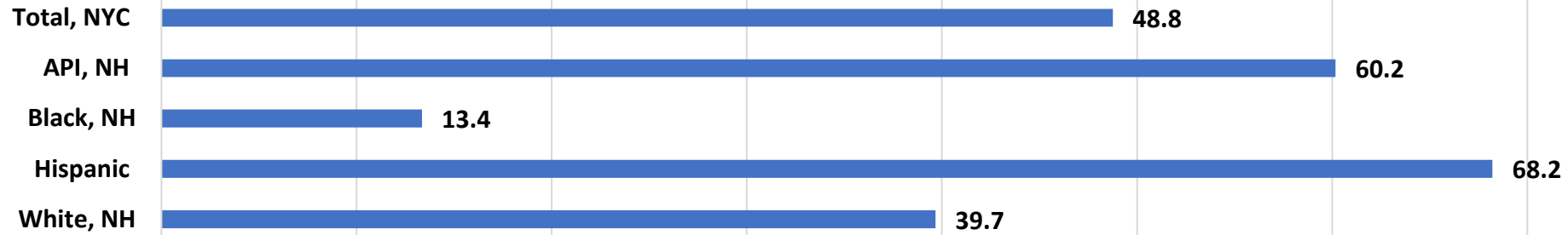

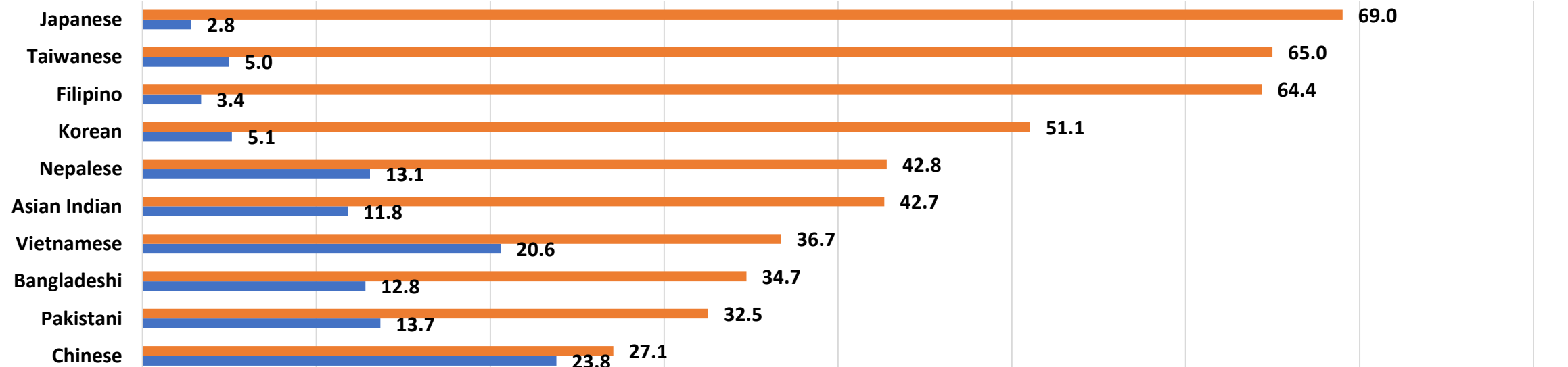

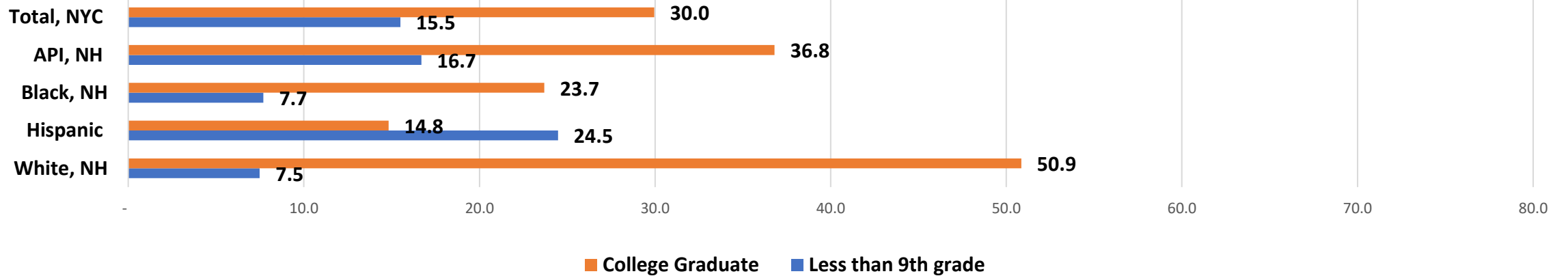

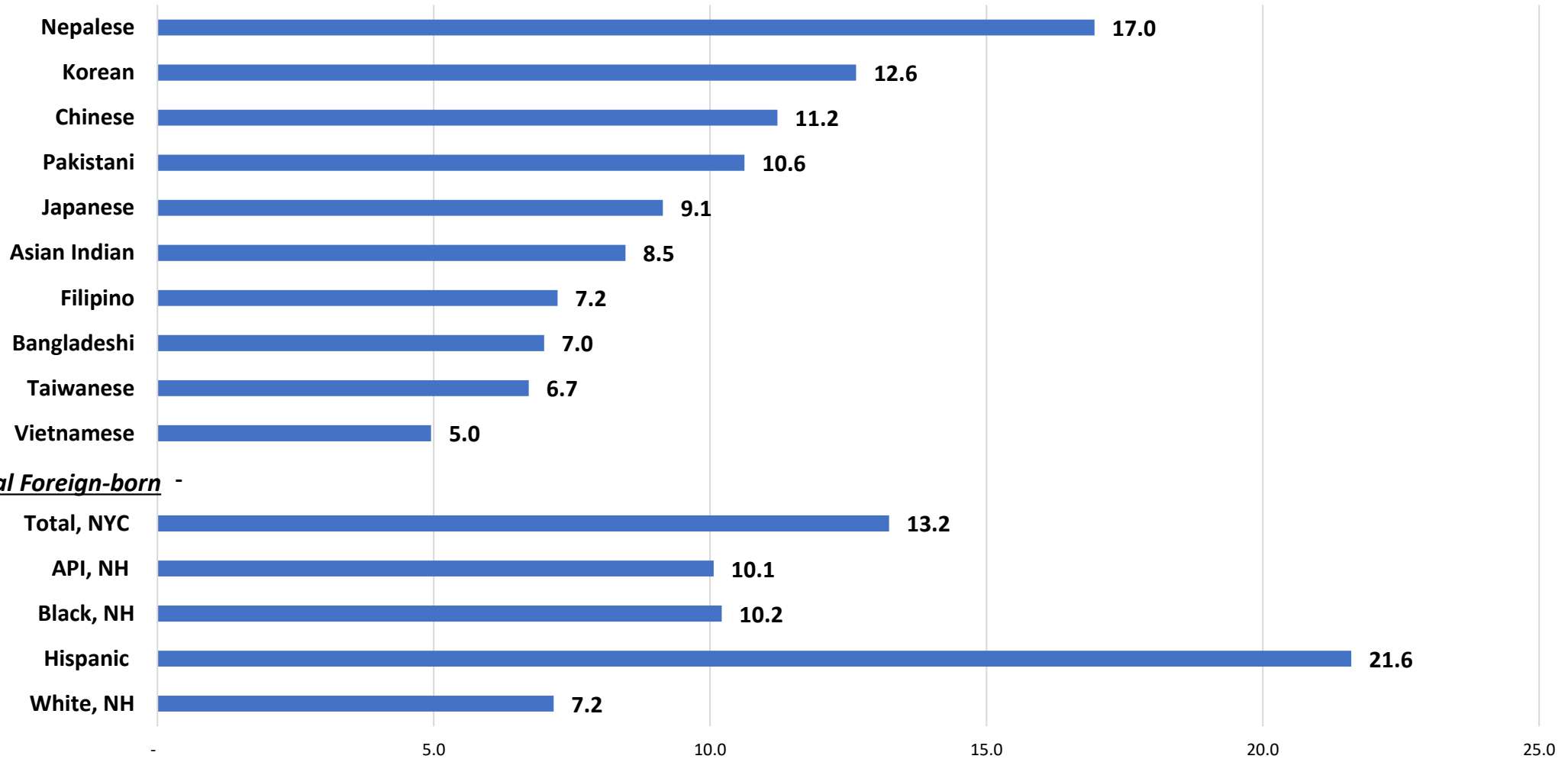

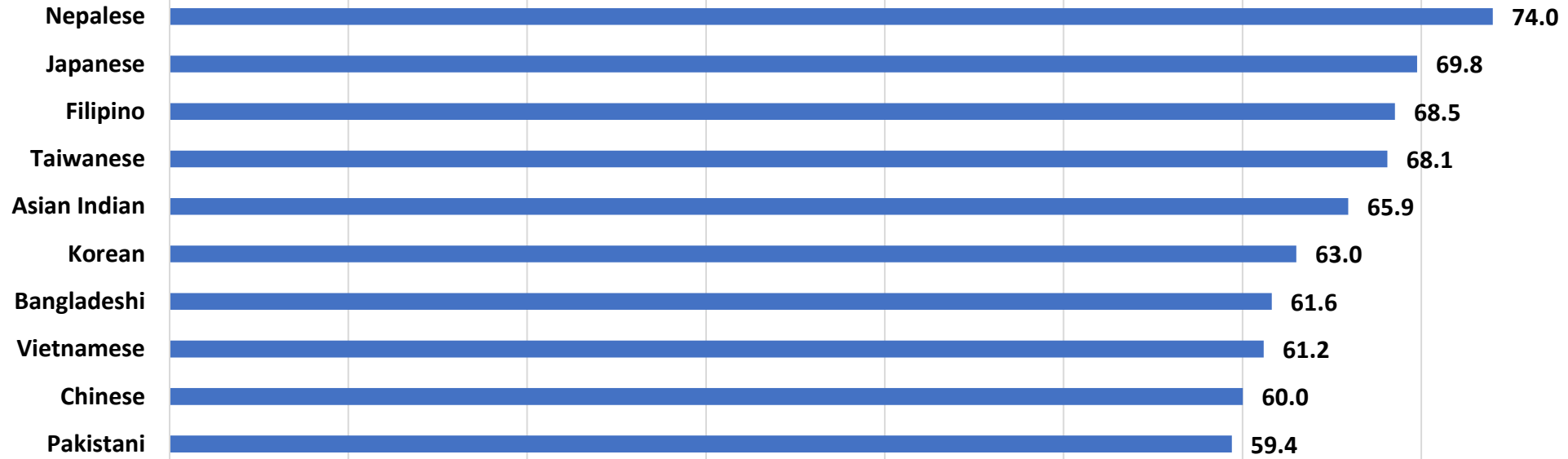

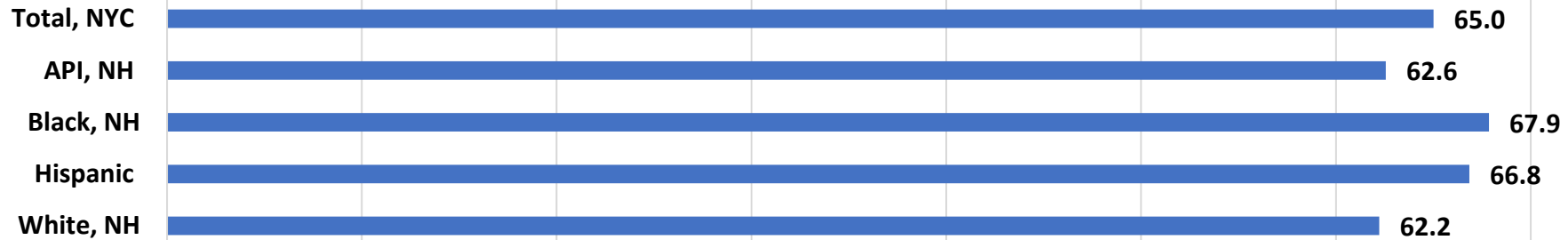

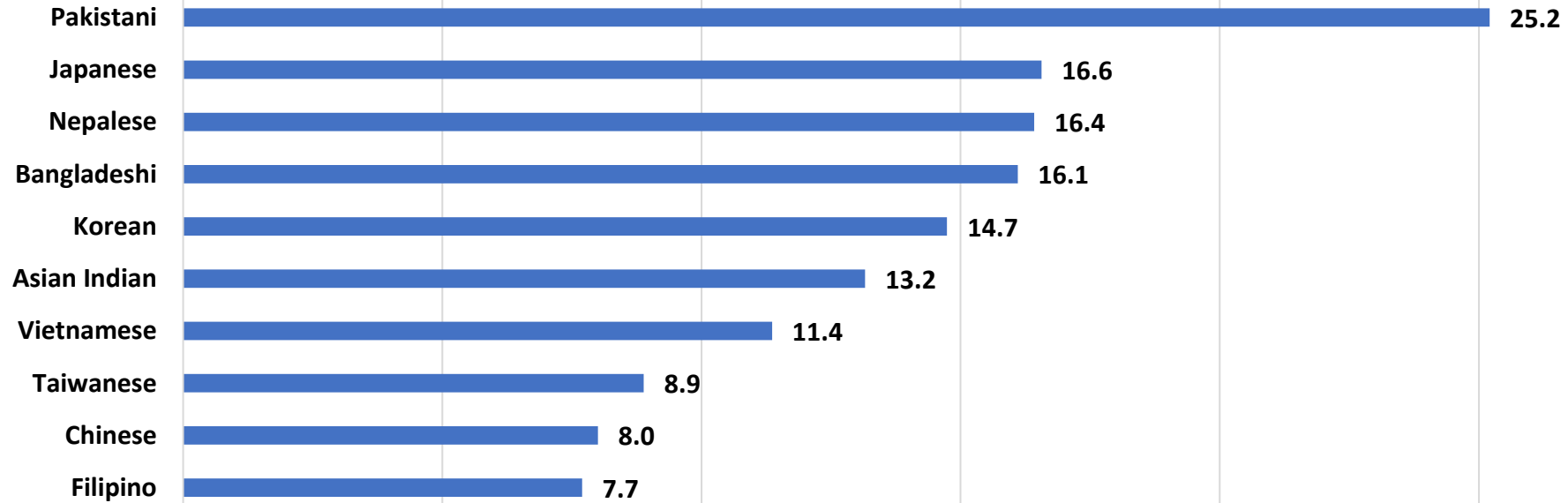

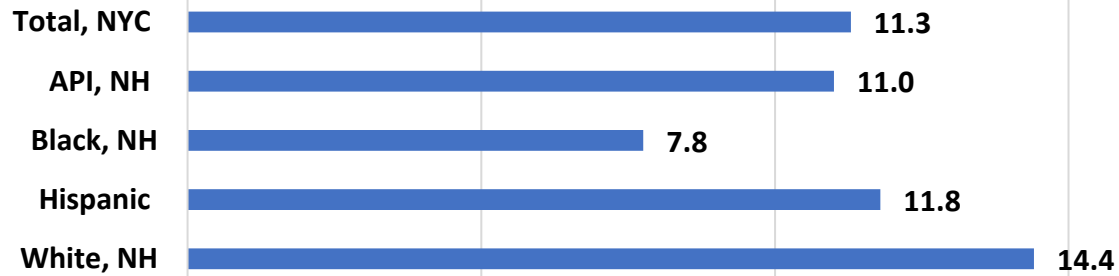

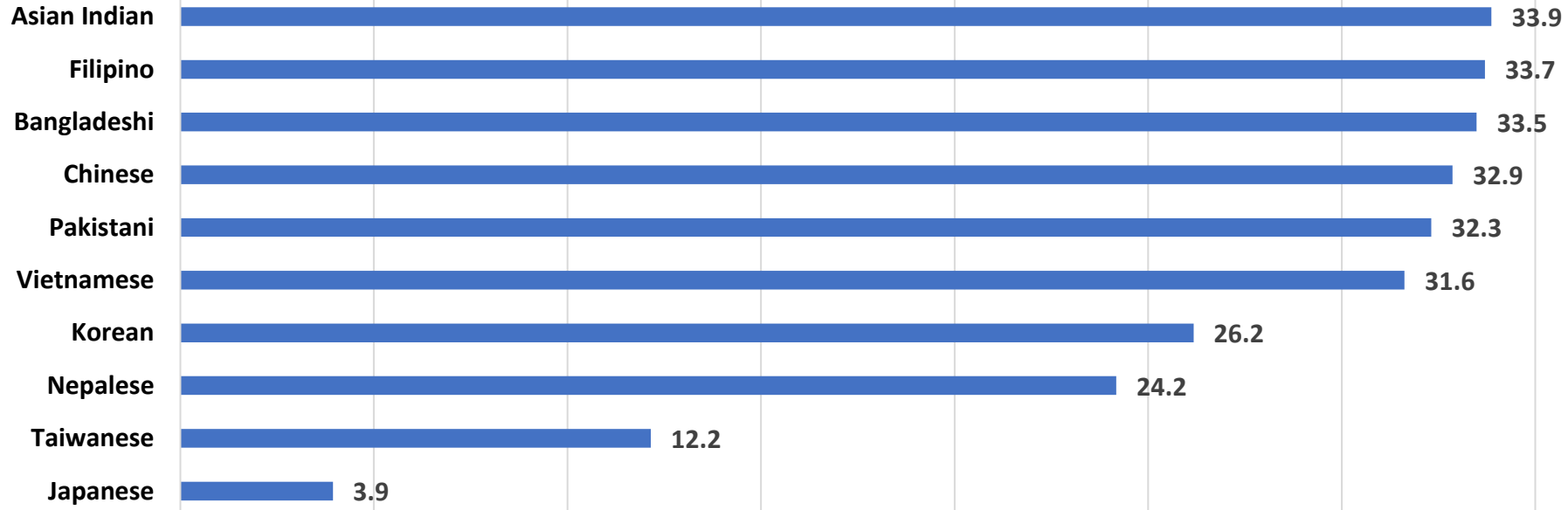

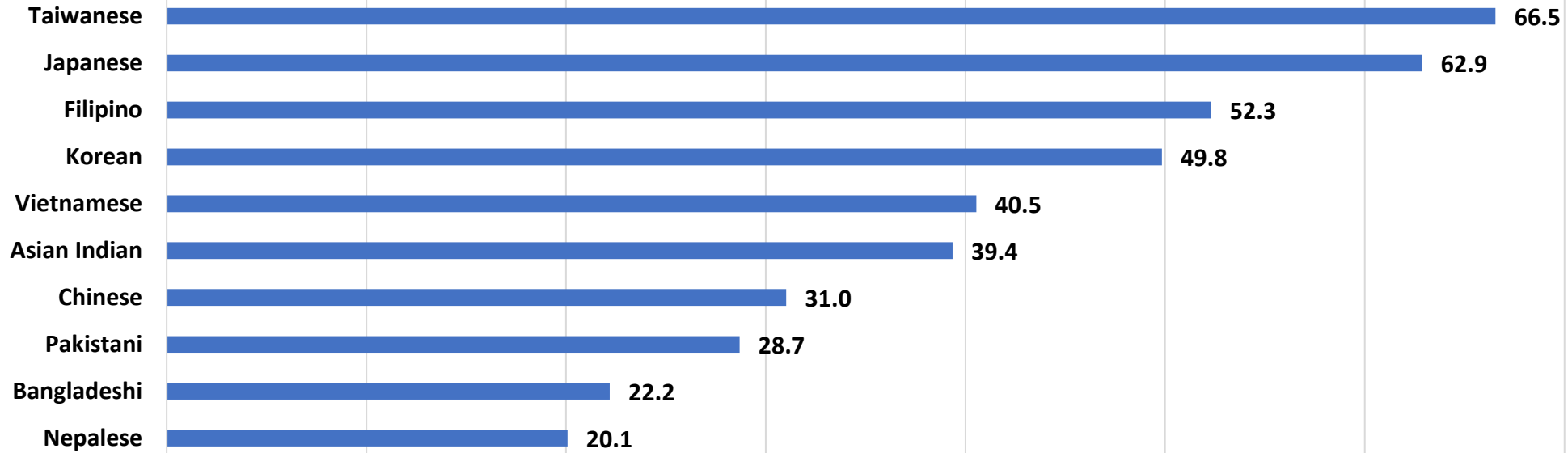

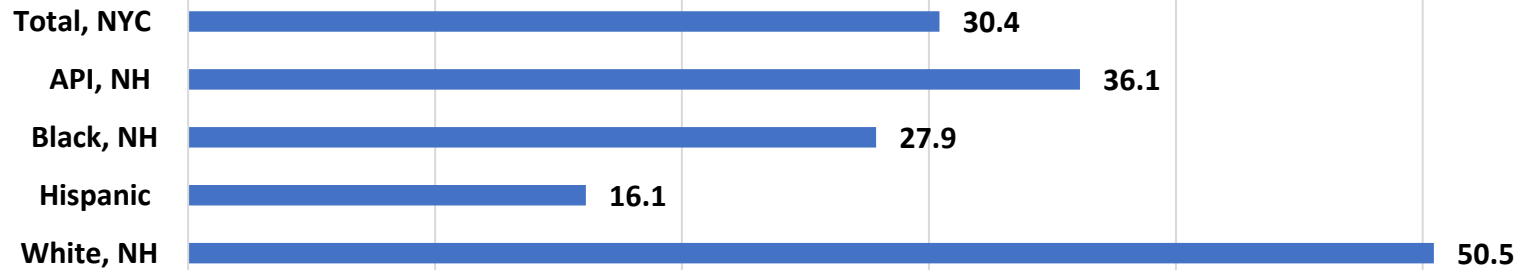

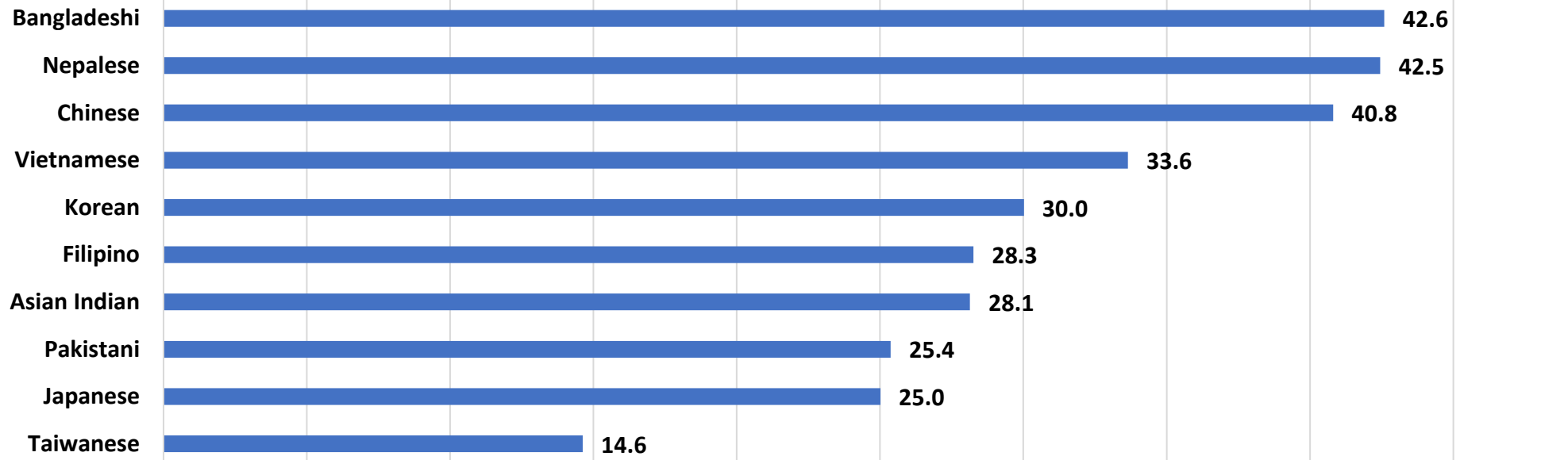

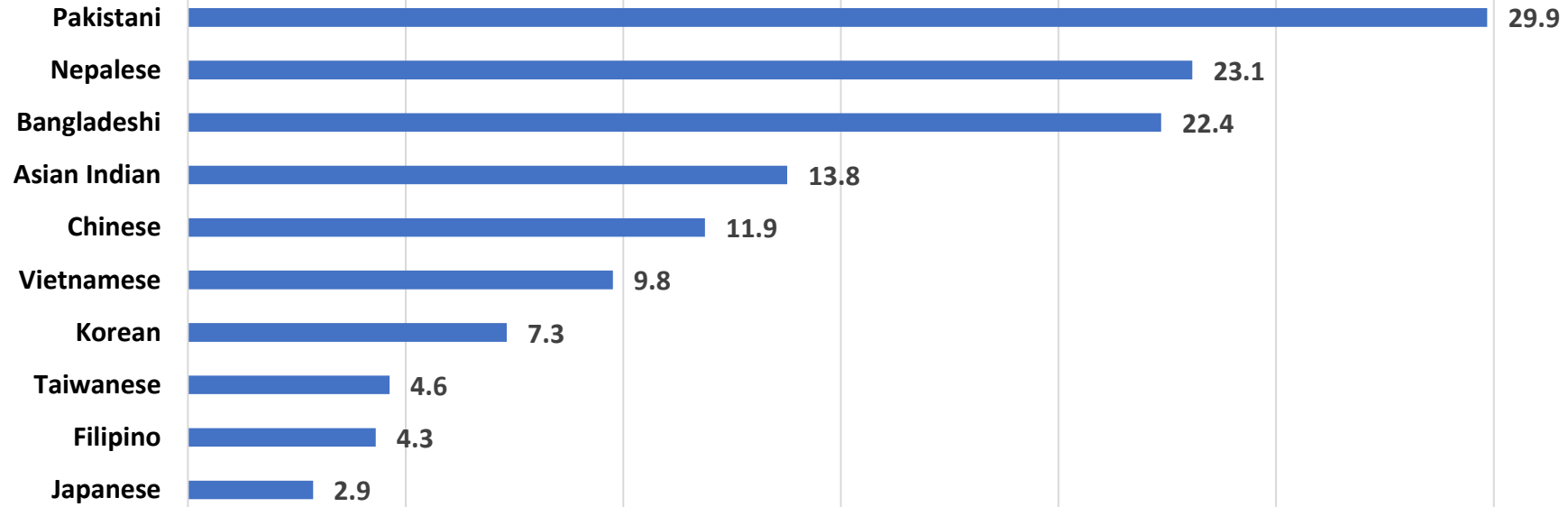

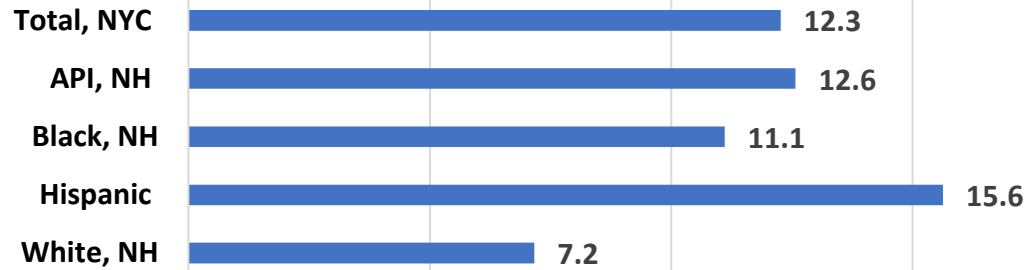

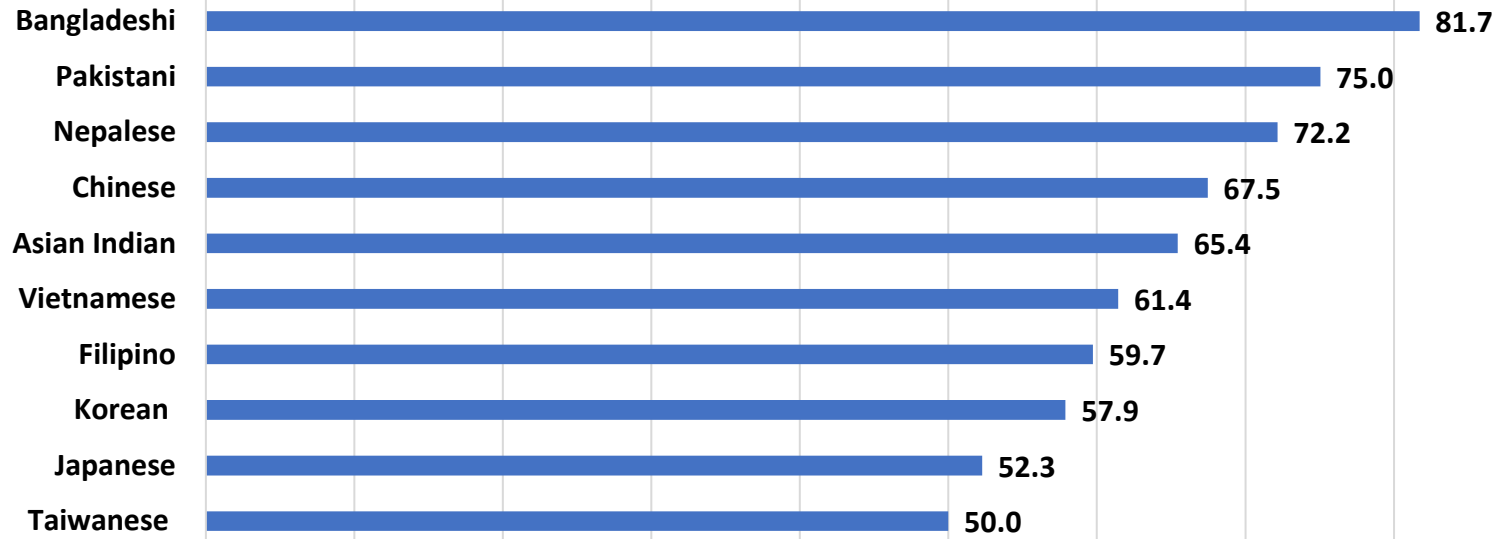

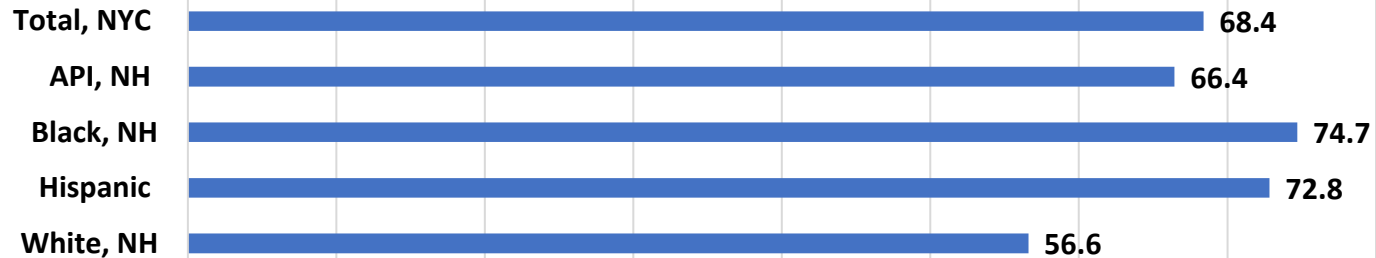

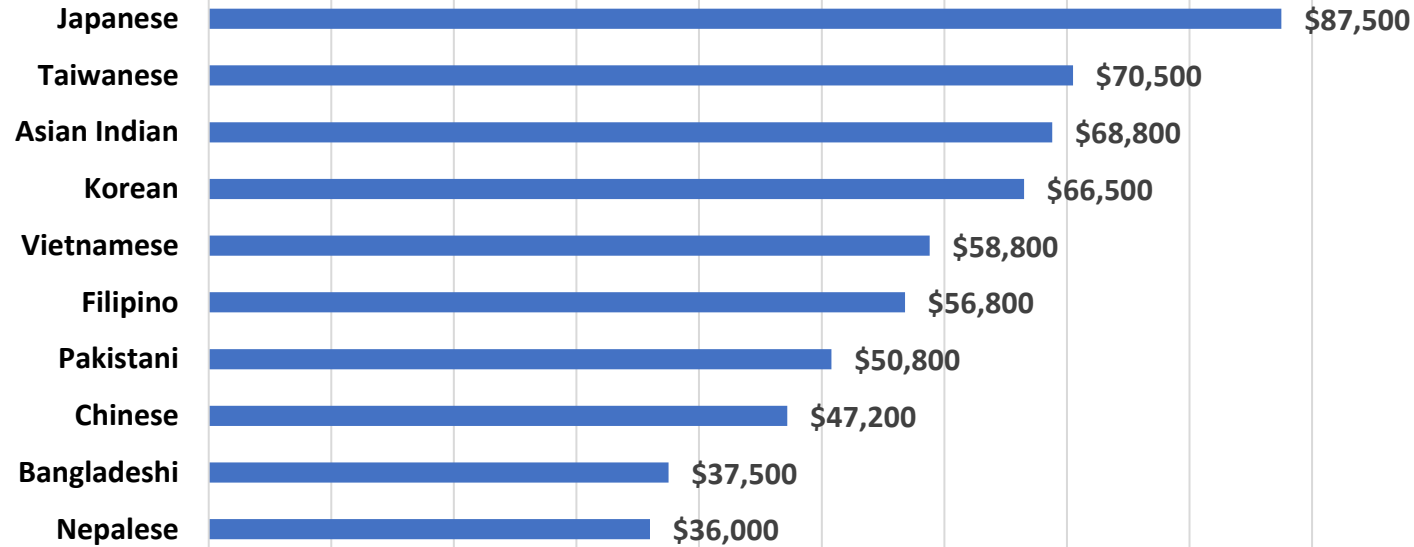

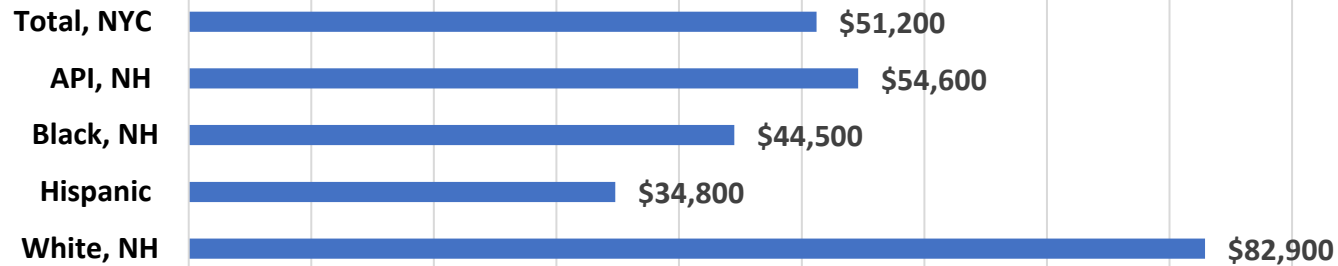

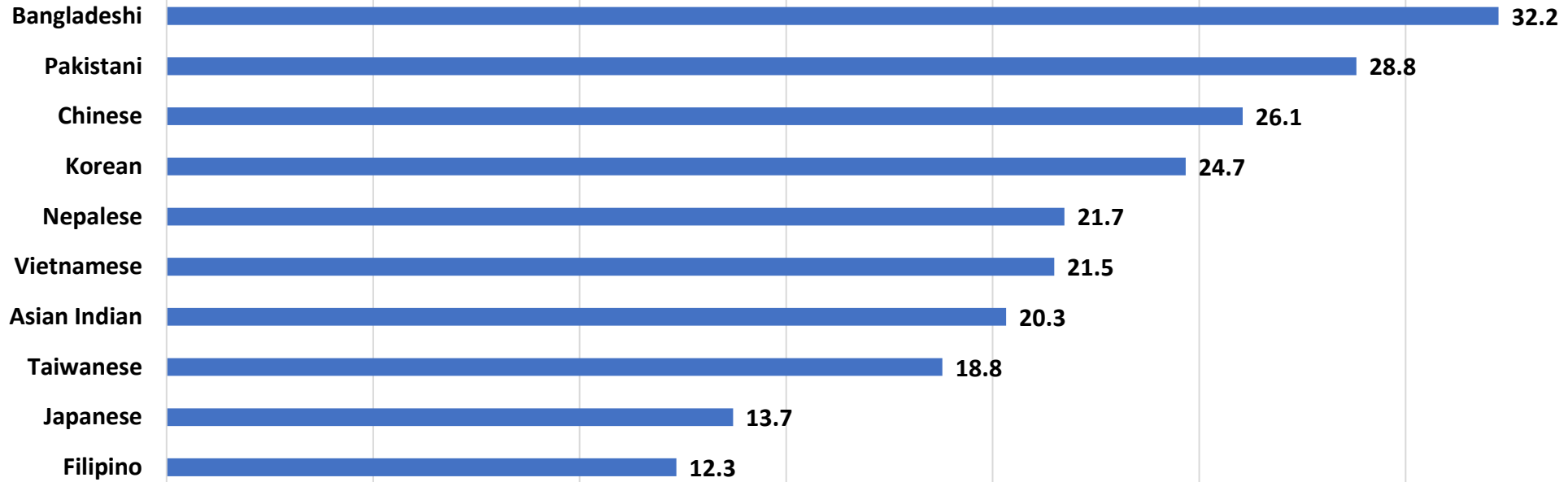

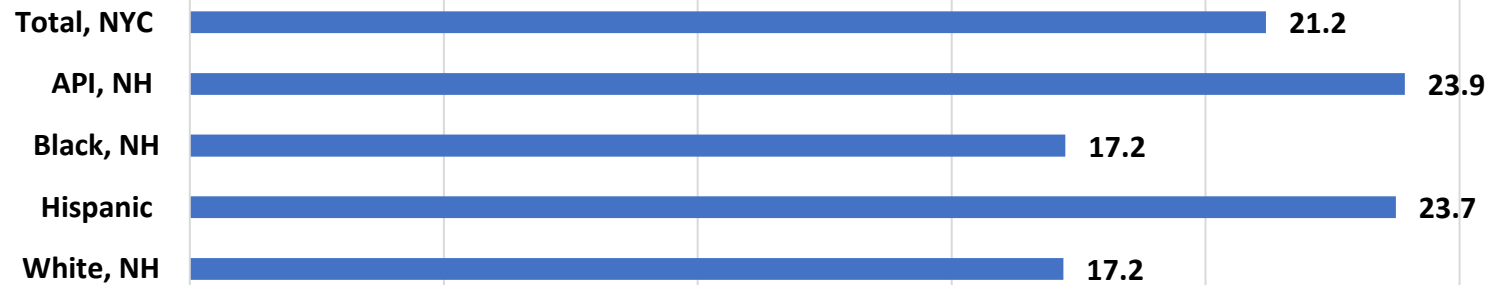

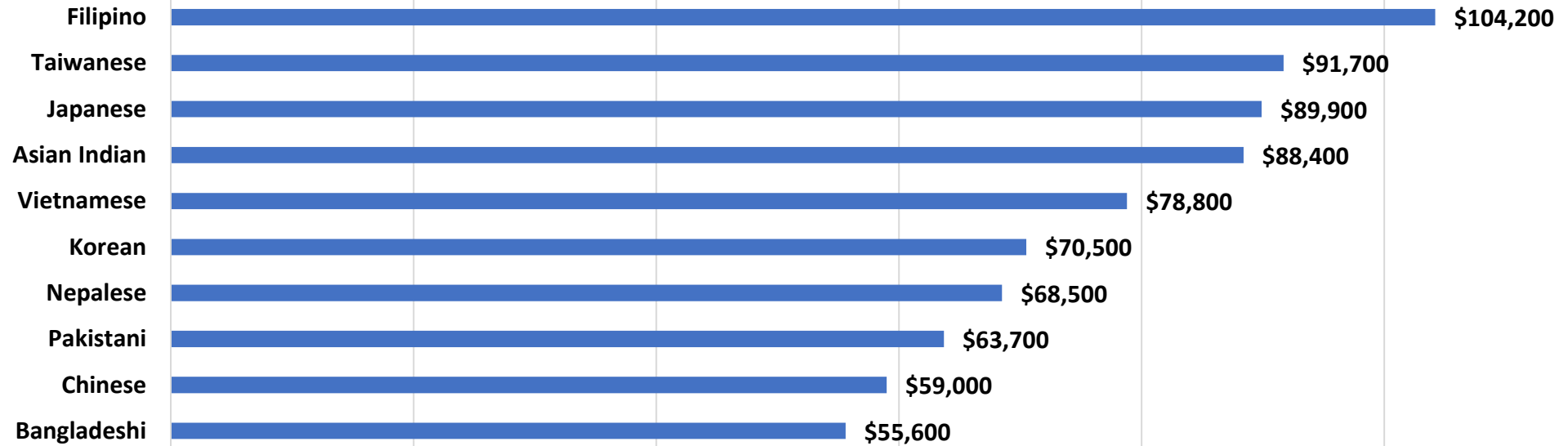

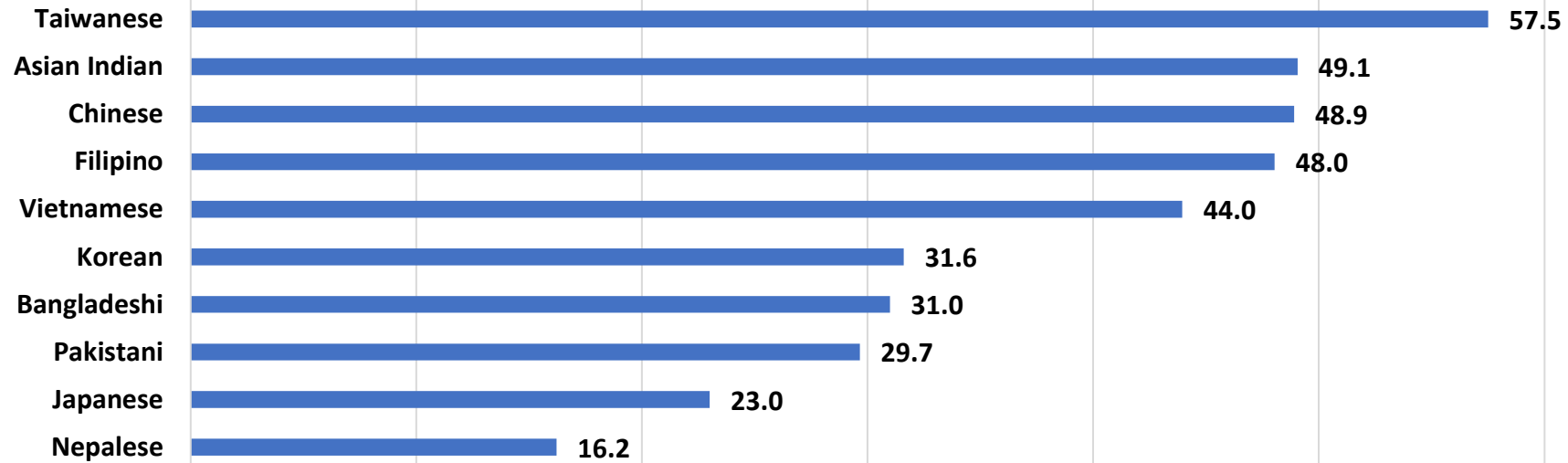

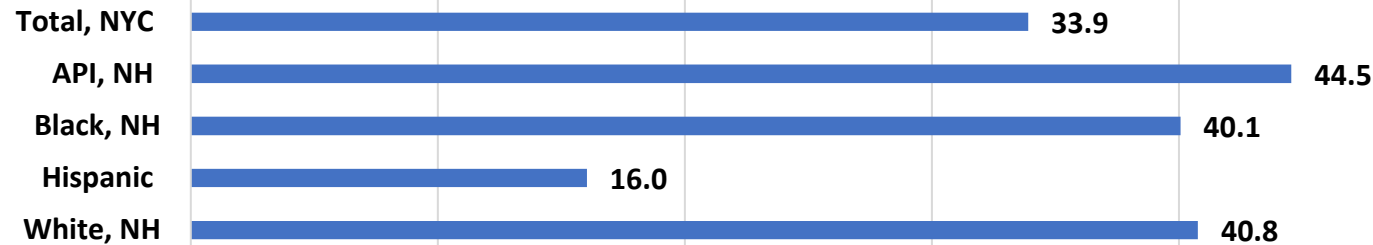

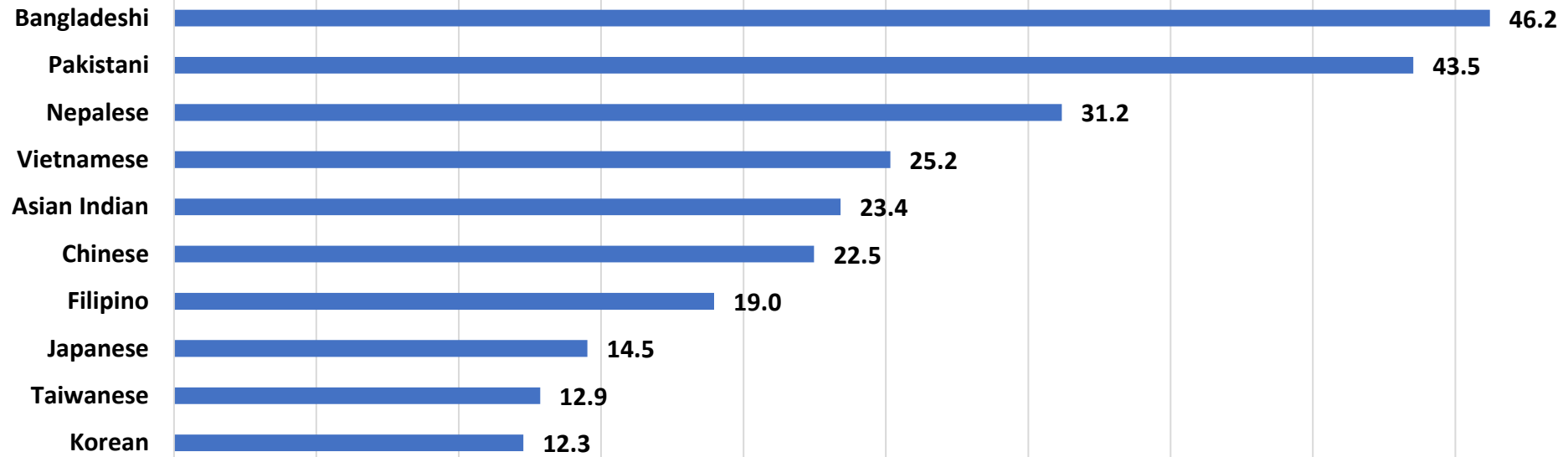

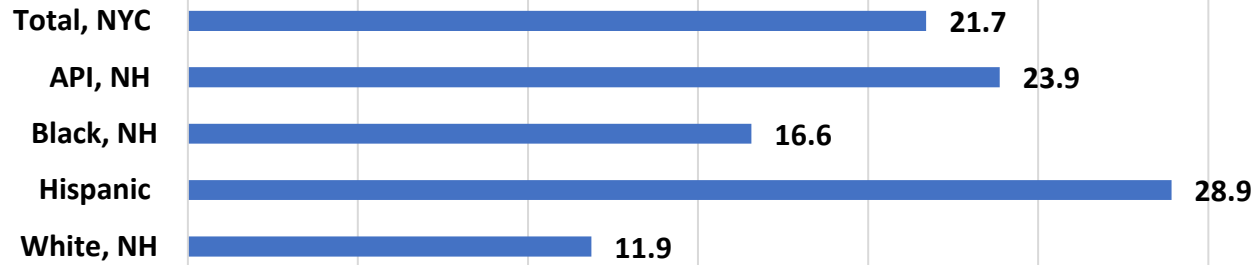

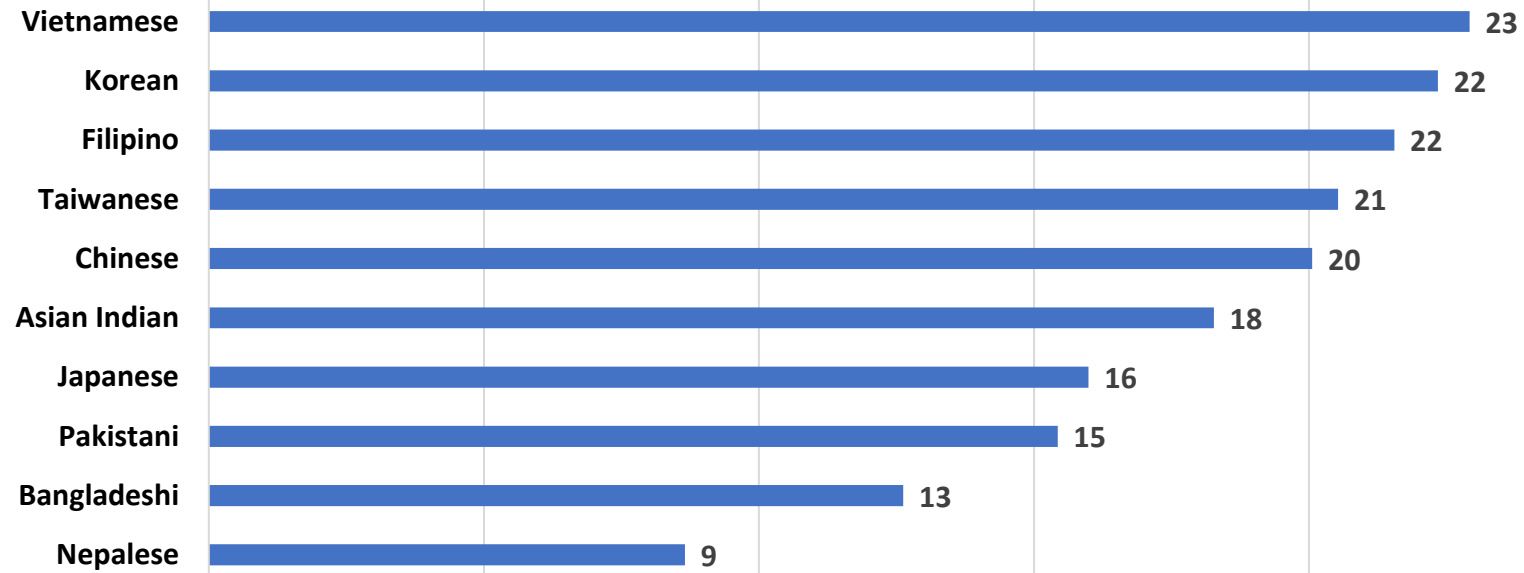

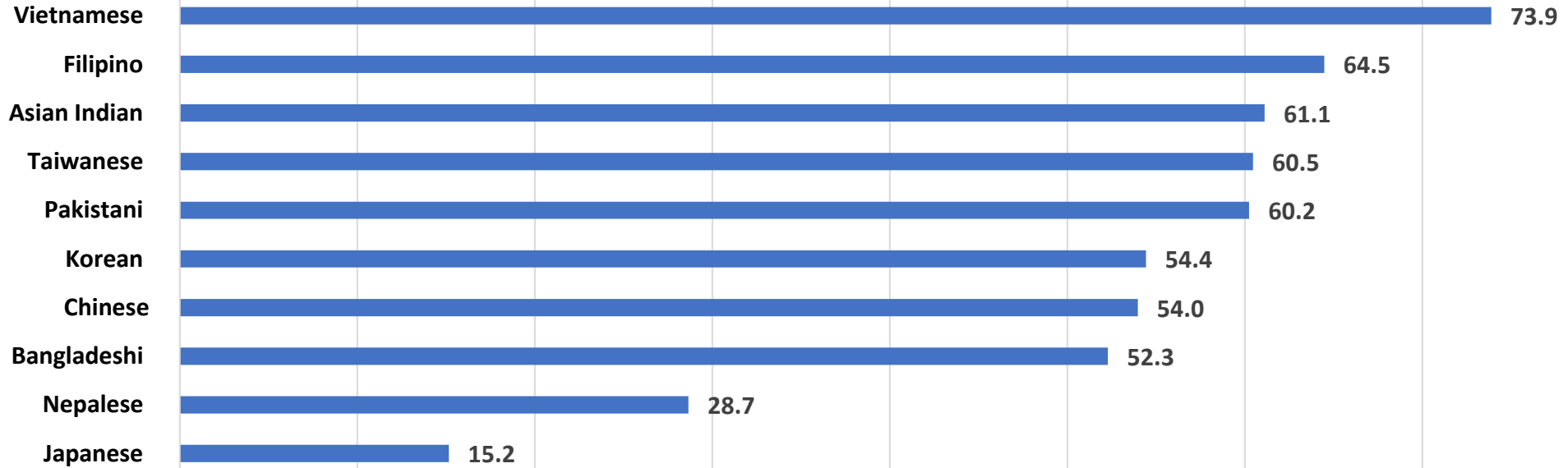

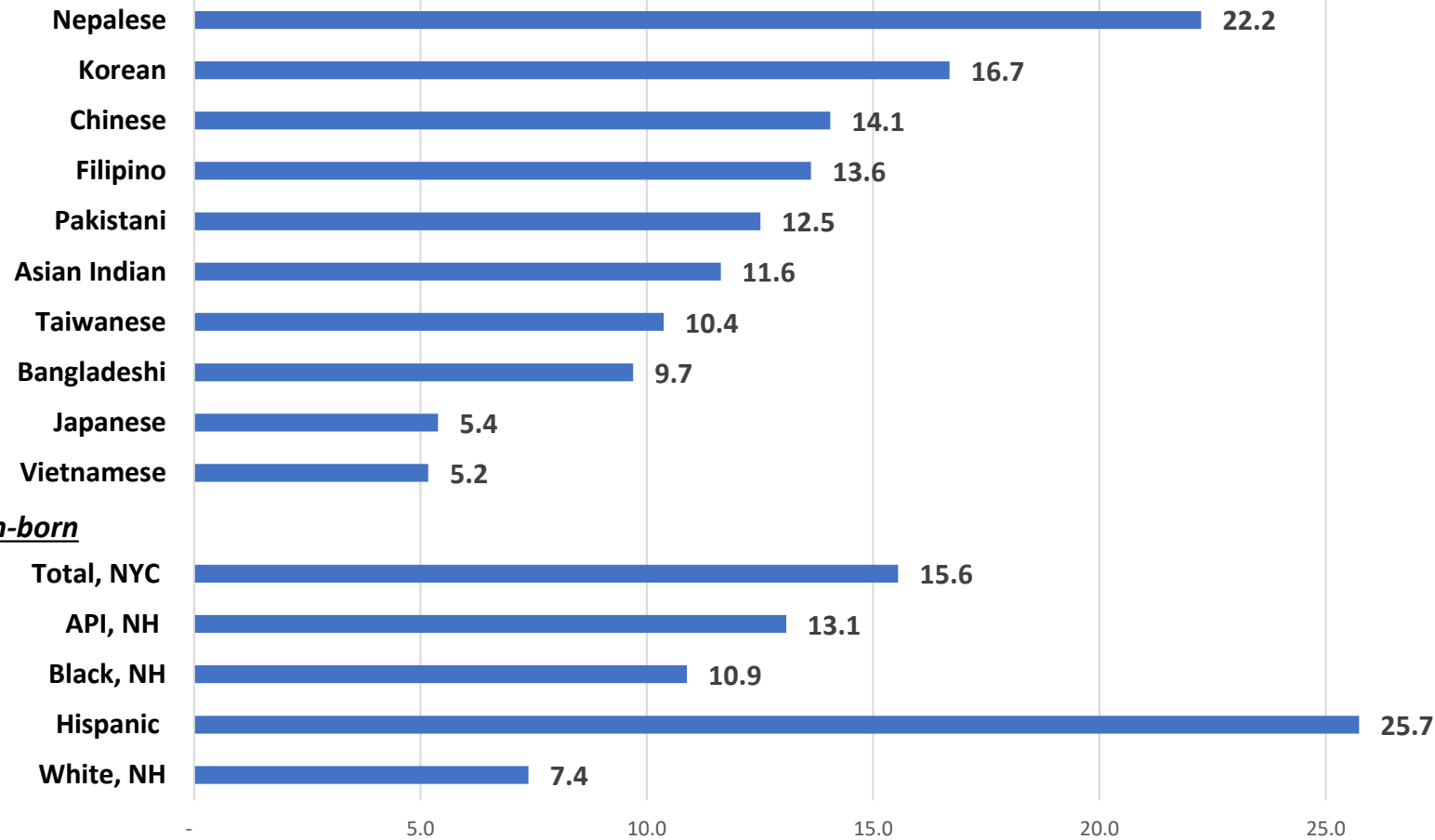

Undocumented Immigrants (%)

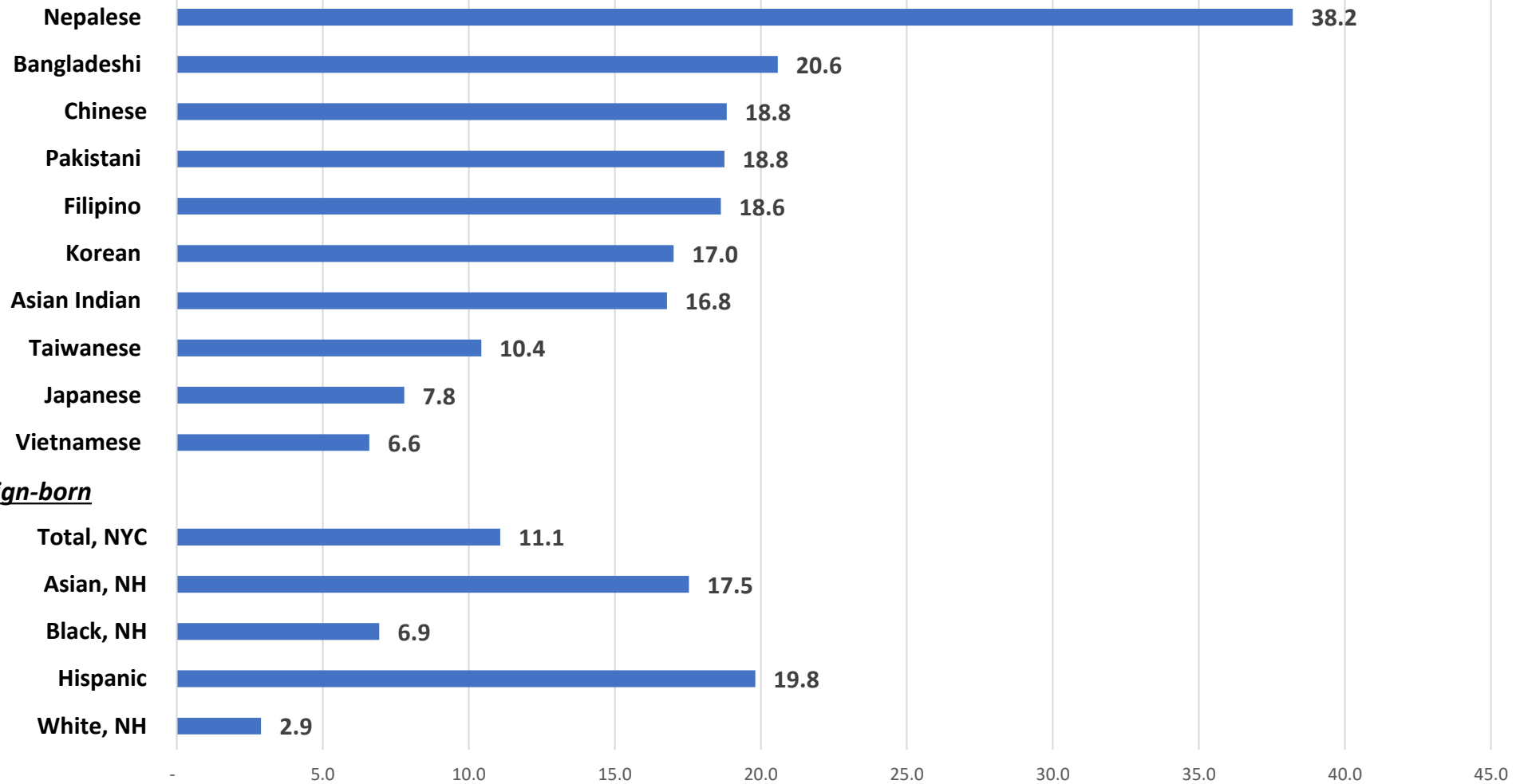

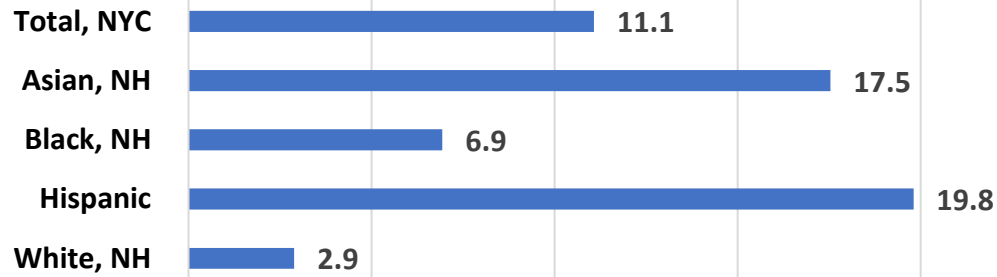
