CANDIDATE TO CORRECTION OFFICER IN 12-17 months.



Candidates learn about DOC careers at recruiting events



NOE posted to DCAS website



Candidates file and take exam (\$61)



Passers are added to a list and receive a list number . DCAS sends list to DOC . (4-6 months)



AIU calls candidates to start screening process (6 weeks - 6 months)



Candidates must successfully complete a written and oral psychological exam



Candidates must successfully complete **background investigation** (\$75)



Candidates must pass medical exam



Candidates attend orientation



Candidates must **undergo agility** test



Candidates who've passed all of these steps go on to The Academy



5 months of training (physical, on the job, theory)



After 5 months, candidates graduate and become Correction Officers



CANDIDATES:

The process will vary depending on your individual circumstances. **Generally**, candidates with a short employment history; no background issues; and whose schedules are flexible to come in for screening move through the process in about a year.
