


1901 MAP

The site of the current Bandshell and Playground was originally an open archery field. The entire area was defined by an oval path with an immediate connection to the Ninth Street Entrance.

The Bandshell structure and the original Playground were constructed in 1941 the year after this map (showing an approximate building footprint) was made.








1980 SURVEY


The Bandshell and Playground shown in this survey as they were installed in 1941. As you can see the playground extended into the northern oval where there is currently more lawn.



2015 SURVEY

The Bandshell structure and the adjacent playground, now called Harmony Playground, were reconstructed in 2001. The Bandshell was enlarged, but the playground was decreased in size on the north side.




1 - Existing Adult Fitness West Side




