

#### Concerns Raised by LPC 7/14/2020:

- Obstructs view of seaport & river
- Puts pedestrians in harmsway
- Height of ceiling obstructs view
- Ceiling area too large
- Wood decking is of the pier, not the street
- Size: 2,548 SF

### Mancini Duffy Design





#### **Proposed Blockhouse Solutions:**


- Moved west of Tin Building
- Adjacent to Tin Building seating
- Views no longer obstructed
- Minimized ceiling to only cover bar & kitchen
- Wood decking relates to Tin Building seating
- Size: 1,540 SF

#### **Community Board Concerns Raised:**

- Minimize roof profile
- Raise roof as high as possible
- Maximize extent of glass facing the Tin Building
- Consider the transition between the Blockhouse
   & Tin Building seating






# Longitudinal Section






