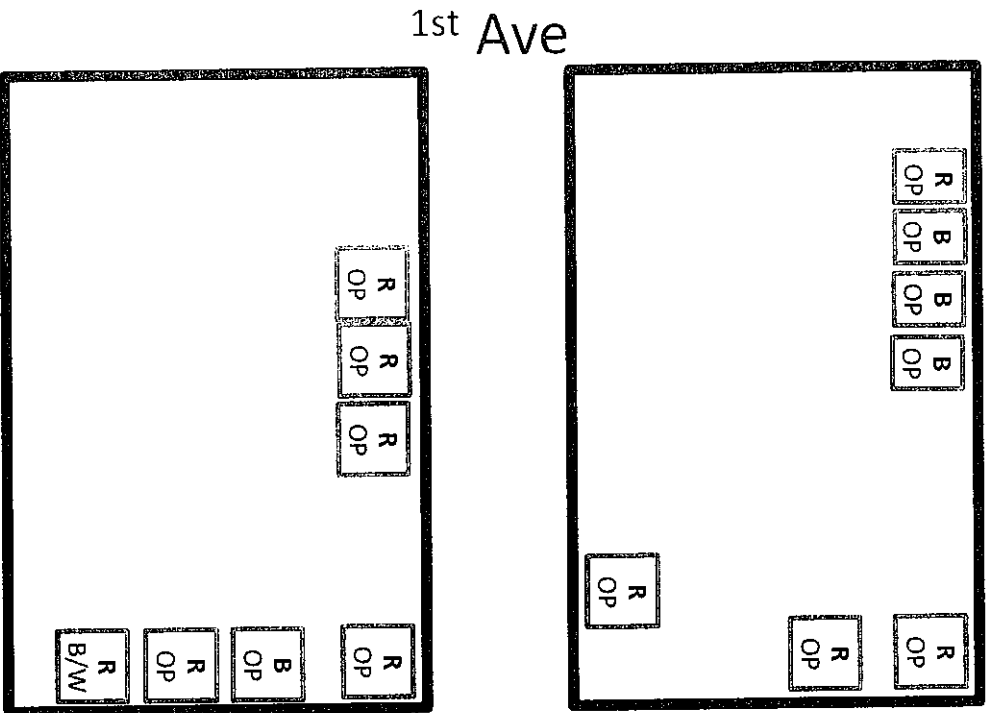
Diagram for liquor license

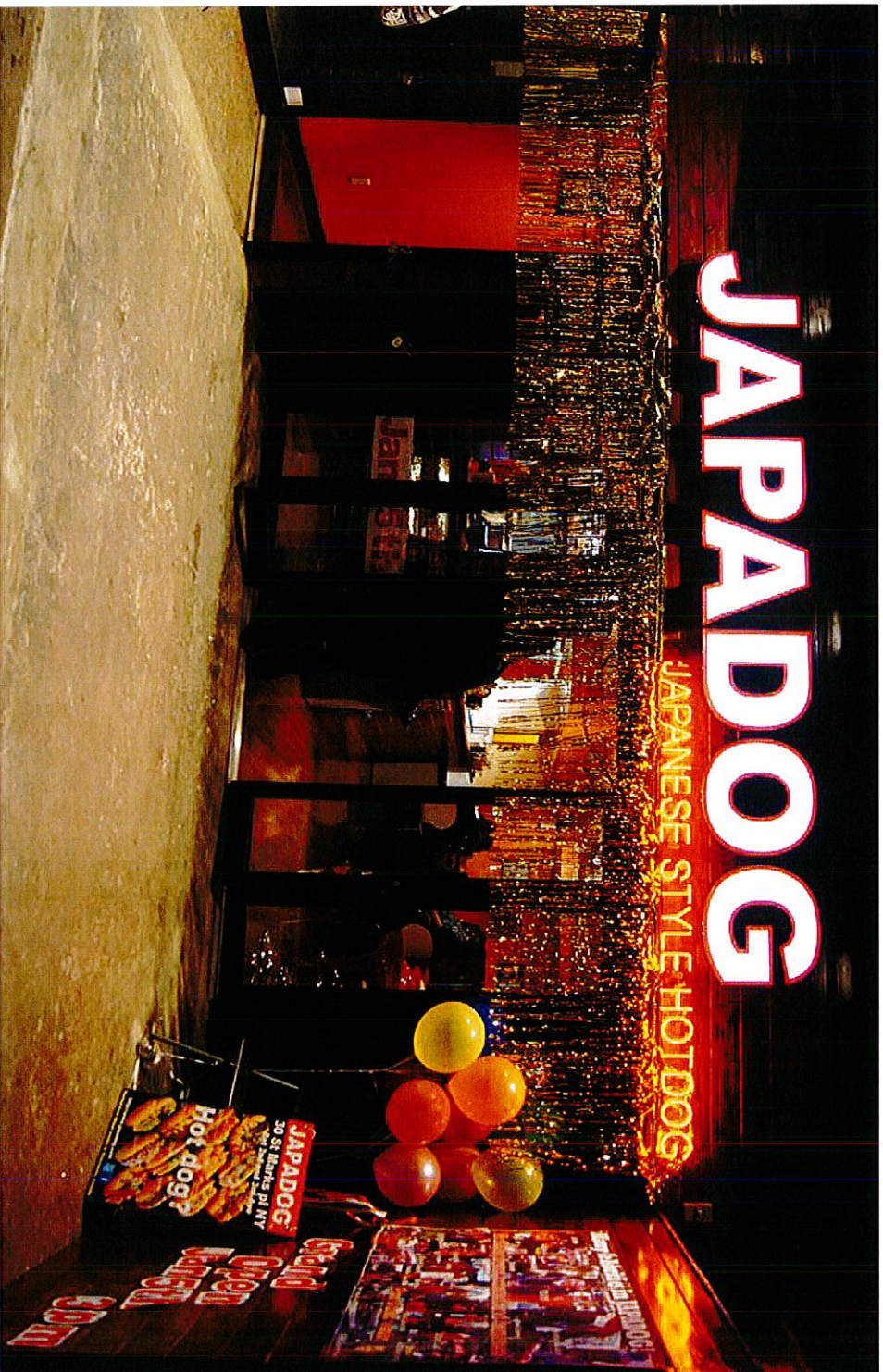
