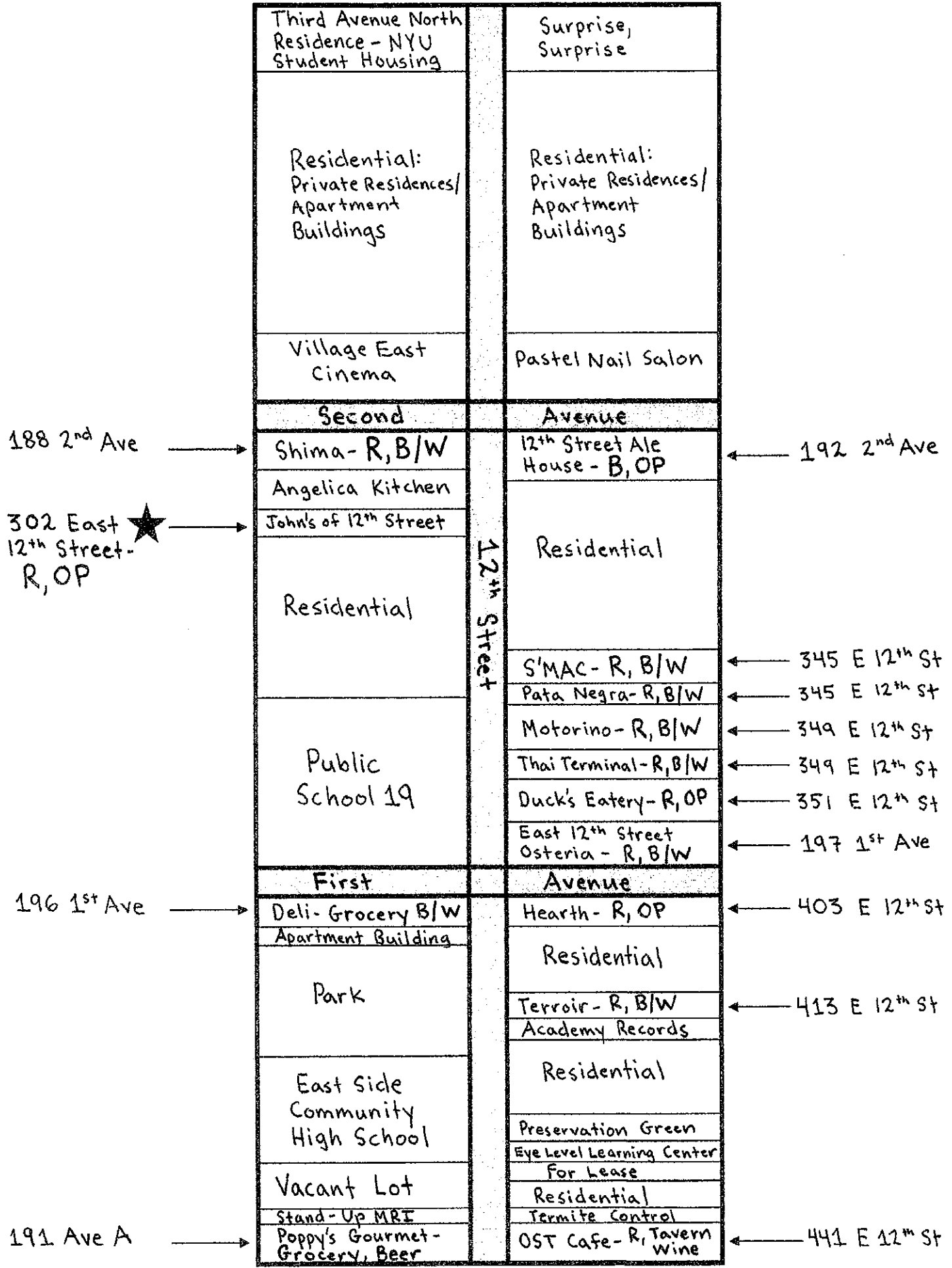

Vehicular Traffic and Crowd Management

To the best of my knowledge, John's of 12th Street has not received many noise or traffic complaints in its 105 year history. Our operation will not vary dramatically from the current operation. Thus, we do not foresee these issues being problematic moving forward. If a crowd does gather outside the premises on a particular evening, and the manager on duty is capable of controlling the situation, then he or she will ensure that any noise coming from this crowd is mitigated or eliminated in a timely fashion, and the crowd is directed either inside the establishment, or dispersed from the area. Should an issue develop at some point in the future, we will hire a security service to assist with vehicular traffic coordination, as well as crowd control on the sidewalk.

Noise Control Inside and Outside Establishment

The managers on duty will ensure that the noise from our patrons stays at a reasonable volume during all hours of operation. Any potential unruly tables will be dealt with accordingly. Additionally, the background music will be kept at a reasonable volume during all hours of operation, and all doors will remain closed throughout service. Should noise issues outside of the venue arise in the future, we will hire a security service to monitor the activity of our patrons outside of the establishment.

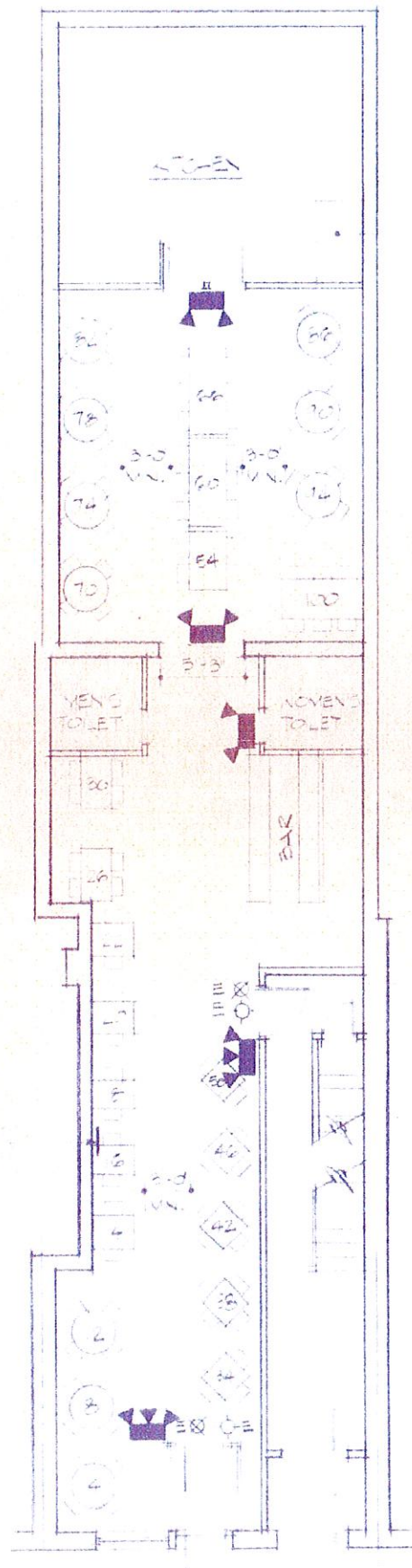
