Extent of Food Service and Proposed Menu for 98 Avenue C

"Wine Bar" will operate under a TAVERN WINE/BEER license and will be serving limited food. All food items will be stored in refrigerators or sealed containers during and between service. The goal of the menu is to reflect and compliment the wine selection. We will not have any ovens, grills, or other appliances requiring ventilation.

Proposed 'Wine Bar' Menu

OLIVES and NUTS

castelvetranos and marconas (both come in tubs, castelvetranos require refrigeration, marconas do not, both can be totally sealed)

GIARDINIERA

seasonal pickled vegetables (sourced from BK brine, tubs refrigerated)

SEASONAL SPREADS

spring pea and ricotta, roasted pepper (other options: hummus) (prepped at ABC Beer Co using their food processor—1-2 times a week, produce from green market, no fresh food distributer/large deliveries, nothing that can't be made with a food processor, minimal waste)

ANTIPASTI

roasted tomatoes, chorizo, fresh mozzarella, white beans (all except white beans (canned) sourced from beer store, long shelf life, minimal waste)

BOCCORONES

white anchovies (canned)

'NDUJA AND PARMESAN

cured meat spread

('nduja and parm require refrigeration, but both have long (4-6 week) shelf lives, aka, not much waste)

*Most of these menu items will be served with focaccia, sourced from Pain D'avignon via ABC Beer.

^{**}Wine list will be entirely taps=no bottle waste (no flies, less trash, etc)

^{***}Any food (minimal) leftovers will be stored in sealed plastic containers overnight and during service.

Principal Managing Members for 98 Avenue C

David Hitchner is owner of Alphabet City Wine Co. at 100 Ave C and Alphabet City Beer Co. at 96 Ave C. As a neighborhood resident of eight years, he's well aware of the sense of community in the East Village and the responsibilities of area business owners.

Nora O'Malley has worked in various parts of the wine industry since 2009, and as manager at Alphabet City Wine Co. since September 2013. She is a certified Sommelier who is passionate about taking the pretension out of the wine buying process. Having worked at both Alphabet City Wine Co. and Alphabet City Beer Co. for the past year, she has become well-acquainted with the community and local residents, and is eager to build a new business in the East Village.

Phoebe Connell has a Masters in Food Studies from NYU and has worked in the New York food and beverage industry for more than three years. She currently splits her time between her positions as Director of Education at the Bedford Cheese Shop in Gramercy and as Food Manager at ABC Beer Co., where she has worked since the business opened in 2012. Her appreciation for the Alphabet City community has been a crucial aspect of her decision to pursue her business goals on Avenue C.

How do you plan to manage vehicular traffic and crowds on the sidewalk caused by your establishment? Please attach plans (please do not answer "we do not anticipate congestion.")

- The space is small and will have a very limited capacity, so we will not be open to large crowds. ----We will require guests to have a seat in order to be served (i.e. no crowding at the bar).
- Our staff plans to monitor and disperse of any crowds gathering on the sidewalk
- There will not be a line or any sort of "red rope" on the sidewalk
- There is free street parking throughout the East Village.
- We anticipate most of our patrons to be locals, who will be walking to the establishment

How do you plan to manage noise inside and outside your business so neighbors will not be affected? Please attach plans.

- · We plan to install sound-proofing
- We do not plan to have live or loud music for any reason
- The space is very small with limited seating capacity, so general noise pollution will always be kept to a minimum
- We will not have a kitchen, so business noise will be just the refrigerator compressors, AC, and dishwasher, which will be operating predominantly during service hours.
- We will close all doors and windows by 10pm
- We will put signs up requesting patrons to respect the neighbors as they leave.
- We will ask patrons who smoke to please be respectful of neighbors.
