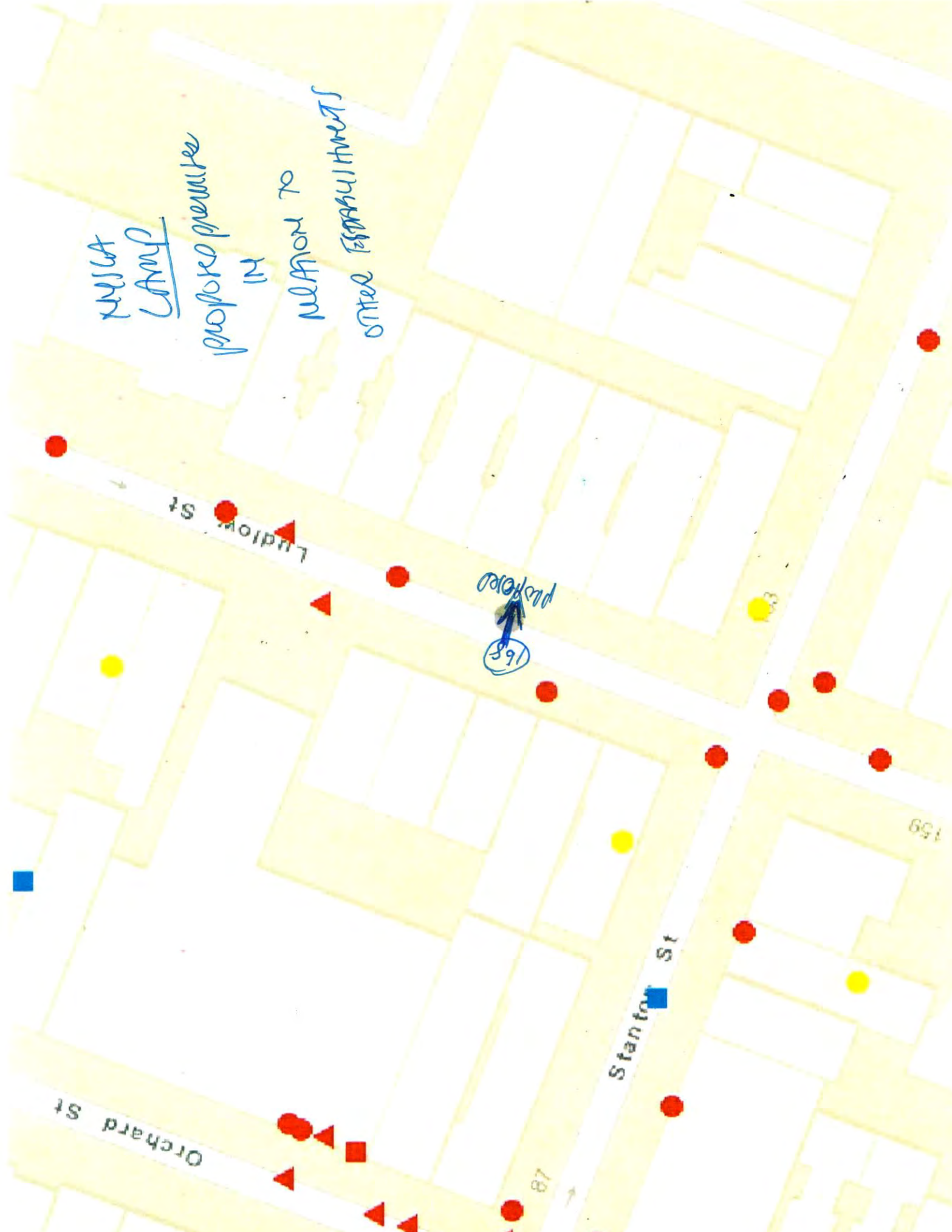

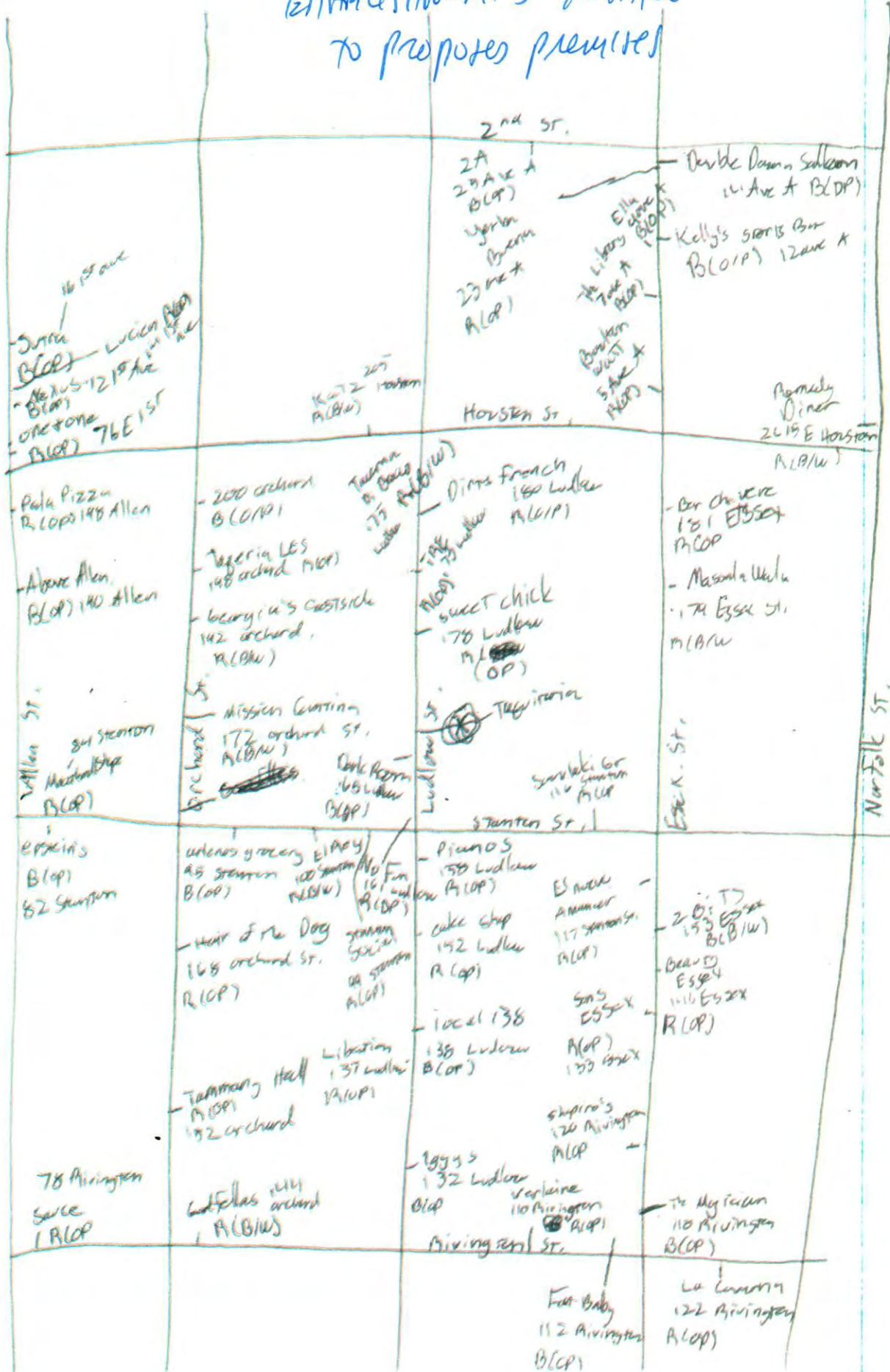

### Banks That Struck Deals in Past May Be Forced to Plead Guilty

By BEN PROFFER and JESSICA SILVER-GREENBERG

It might be the Wall Street equivalent of a parole violation. Just two years after pleading innocent to a variety of crimes, some of the world's bigest banks are suspected of having broken their promises to behave.

A mixture of new cases and lingering problems could violate earlier settlements that imposed new practices and limits on the banks, according to lawyers involved in the cases. Prosecutors are exploring whether to strengthen the earlier deals, the lawyers said, or scrap them altogether and force the banks to plead guilty to a crime.

Their effort, unfolding separately from a number of well-known investigations into Wall Street, has expanded several past deals and consulting firms that until now were thought to be in the clear.

Prosecutors in Washington and Manhattan have reopened an investigation from Stanford Chartered, the big British bank that reached a settlement in 2012 over accusations that it transferred billions of dollars for loan and other outside blackboard by the United States, according to the lawyers briefed on the cases. The prosecutors say "reopening" whether Stanford Chartered, which has a large operation in New York, failed to disclose the extent of its wrongdoing to the government, reporting the bank's entire operations.
