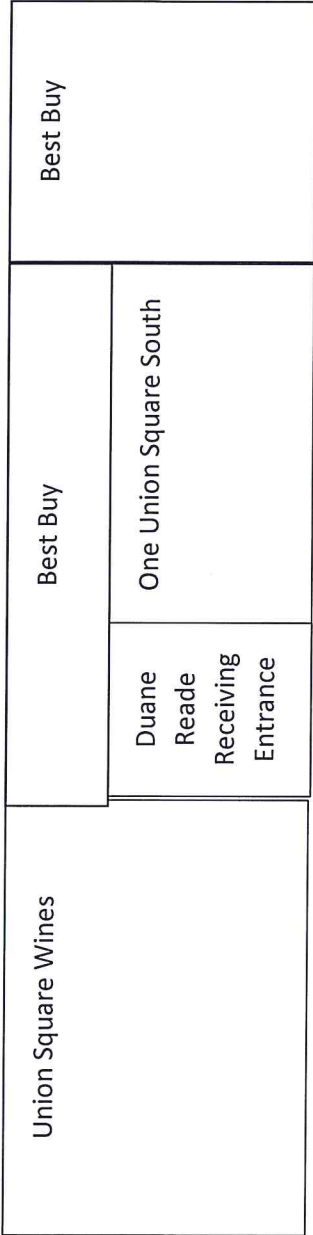
We are including the following questions to be able to prepare stipulations and have the meeting be faster and more efficient. Please answer per your business plan; do not plan to negotiate at the meeting.

1. I will operate a full-service restaurant, specifically a (type of restaurant) American Gastro Pub, with a kitchen open and serving food during all hours of operation OR I have less than full-service kitchen but will serve food all hours of operation.
2. I will close any front or rear façade doors and windows at 10:00 P.M. every night or when amplified sound is playing, including but not limited to DJs, live music and live nonmusical performances.
3. I will not have DJs, live music, promoted events, any event at which a cover fee is charged, scheduled performances, more than 5x DJs / promoted events per year, more than private parties per .
4. I will play ambient recorded background music only. (Except as noted above)
5. I will not apply for an alteration to the method of operation or for any physical alterations of any nature without first coming before CB 3.
6. I will not seek a change in class to a full on-premise liquor license without first obtaining approval from CB 3.
7. I will not participate in pub crawls or have party buses come to my establishment.
8. I will not have a happy hour or drink specials with or without time restrictions OR I will have happy hour and it will end by 7pm.
9. I will not have wait lines outside. I will have a staff person responsible for ensuring no loitering, noise or crowds outside.
10. Residents may contact the manager/owner at the number below. Any complaints will be addressed immediately. I will revisit the above-stated method of operation if necessary in order to minimize my establishment's impact on my neighbors.

Federal Shutdown Seen as Likely

WASHINGTON—Lawmakers braced for the federal government to begin shutting down early Saturday morning, as a one-month spending bill headed toward an expected collapse in a late-night Senate vote.

Facing opposition from most Senate Democrats and some Republicans, the short-term spending bill passed by the House was expected to come short of the 60 votes needed to clear the Senate. With no fallback plan, lawmakers

said they were anticipating a shutdown, which would fall on the first anniversary of President Donald Trump's inauguration.

"I think it is almost 100% likely the government will shut down for some period of time," Rep. John Yarmuth (D, Ky.) said as he left a meeting of other House Democrats. "Everything we see indicates there's no way to avoid a shutdown."

Lawmakers said they had discussed a variety of shorter-

term spending bills, ranging from one day to four weeks, but had not agreed on a plan to avoid even a brief, weekend shuttering of the government.

In a last-ditch effort to strike a deal Friday, Mr. Trump had met in the early afternoon with Sen. Chuck Schumer of New York, the chamber's Democratic leader,

and he called House Speaker Paul Ryan (R, Wis.) later. Although Messrs. Trump and Schumer said progress was made in their meeting, it failed to yield an immediate long-term agreement.

One senator briefed on the meeting between the GOP president and Mr. Schumer said that it didn't go well, putting the onus back on Congress to find a path forward. Another person familiar with the meeting said it wasn't contentious, but that it made

clear that neither side would budge.

Mr. Trump called it an "excellent preliminary meeting in Oval with @SenSchumer" in a tweet Friday evening, writing that they were "making progress."

But without any breakthrough on the immigration
