

1 all in connection with the provision of mobile telecommunications services. 2 3 The proposed franchise agreement has a term of 10 years. 4 5 This summary will apply to all 6 subsequent calendar items being heard here today and will not be repeated. 7 MS. for the draft mobile telecom franchise agreements that are before you.

These agreements, we believe, will serve as the foundation of the City's telecommunications infrastructure for the next decade. Now, more than ever, public safety and other essential services in the City of New York depend on well-functioning and well-maintained telecommunications infrastructure.

A major part of a successful telecommunications ecosystem is a well-trained and reliable work force. That is why CWA is particularly pleased with the inclusion of Appendix H in the agreement, which focuses on worker safety and subcontractor transparency.

Today the wireless industry is plagued by complex multi-layered employment structures and a heavy reliance on subcontractors and independent contractors.

The CWA's research into this part of the industry has uncovered numerous instances of telecom subcontractors

causing fatal gas explosions and utility hits that endanger the public and require public employees' staff time to investigate and resolve. For too often these subcontractors are not properly licensed or registered to work in the state.

The franchisees deploying mobile telecom equipment pursuant to this agreement will be installing these facilities on publicly owned poles and in the public rights-of-way.

As such, it is imperative that the City is knowledgeable of all entities working to deploy network assets under this agreement and to be able to hold them accountable. We hope New York City's leadership on this will be replicated by other municipalities and localities across the nation.

CWA also supports the City's efforts to incentive mobile telecommunications infrastructure build-out in underserved communities as outlined in Appendix B.

We commend the City on its proactive

efforts to close the digital divide and 1 2 position the City to deliver up to date, 3 high quality and reliable telecommunications services to all New 4 5 Yorkers for years to come. 6 Thank you for your time and we 7 support the franchise agreements. 8 MS.
