In accordance with this mission, the DOHMH is seeking up to six (6) appropriately qualified Contractors to develop and implement a Colon Cancer Prevention Navigation Program (CPNP), based in a primary care center (or centers) aimed at increasing screening and timely diagnosis and initiation of treatment for colorectal cancer for those experiencing barriers to care in underserved communities with high cancer mortality and high poverty (target neighborhoods).</p> <p>This solicitation seeks to implement CRC patient navigation in large primary care centers serving underserved populations, such as Federally Qualified Health Centers (FQHCs) and Community Health Centers (CHCs), including safety net hospital-based primary care practices in NYC.</p>
