Procurement Description:	<p>Opioid overdose deaths have reached epidemic levels in New York City. In 2016, there were 1,374 unintentional drug overdose deaths in NYC, compared with 937 unintentional drug overdose deaths in 2015. The rate of unintentional drug overdose death increased for the sixth consecutive year. In 2016, 82% of overdose deaths involved an opioid.</p> <p>Naloxone, a safe and effective medication that can reverse the effects of opioid overdose, is one proven strategy for reducing rates of overdose mortality. In NYC, free naloxone is distributed to lay persons at risk of experiencing or witnessing an overdose by Opioid Overdose Prevention Programs (OOPPs). Organizations across the city can become OOPPs by registering with the New York State Department of Health (NYSDOH). Once registered, OOPPs provide overdose response trainings to clients and staff to teach them how to recognize and respond to an overdose using naloxone.</p>
