ACS contracts with various non-profit organizations to support the needs of children and families by working closely with them in their communities.</p> <p>ACS is seeking providers to implement the Family Assessment Program (FAP). FAP seeks to divert adolescents at risk of out-of-home placement through Family Court via the Persons in Need of Supervision (PINS) process. FAP's mission is to provide immediate support to families in crisis. Through screening and assessment, individualized intervention, and referrals to a range of community-based services and supports, FAP aims to strengthen families and help them stay together.</p>
