Procurement Description:	<p>The purpose of this RFP is to identify providers that can implement Multi-Systemic Therapy for Emerging Adults (MST-EA) to justice involved youth who are in foster care, living independently or for whom an identified care taker is unwilling to participate in treatment or cannot be found. The original treatment model is Multi-systemic therapy (MST) which is an evidence-based treatment model for justice-involved youth aged 12-17.5, with decades of research supporting its effectiveness in reducing recidivism and out-of-home placement and improving family functioning. MST-EA is an adaptation of standard Multi-Systemic Therapy (MST) designed for young people aged 16-26 with extensive systems involvement (i.e., juvenile justice system, criminal justice system and/or child welfare system) and multiple co-occurring problems (i.e., mental health, substance abuse, behavioral health, homelessness, childhood trauma, etc.) who are living on their own, with family or friends, in foster care or in group homes. ACS only serves youth up to 21 so our age group for our MST-EA will be ages 16 to 21 years.</p>
