Procurement Description: The Department of Health and Mental Hygiene (DOHMH) is seeking to award up to three (3) contracts for improving chlamydia and gonorrhea screening and treatment. The goals of this RFP are to: improve chlamydia and gonorrhea screening rates among uninsured women less than 25 years of age, and uninsured men who have sex with men (MSM); provide treatment to all uninsured persons infected with chlamydia or gonorrhea; obtain accurate estimates of chlamydia and gonorrhea test prevalence and treatment rates; and share trends and best practices in chlamydia/gonorrhea screening and treatment across selected organizations. The contractors would provide clinical services in high-morbidity neighborhoods in Brooklyn, Bronx and Manhattan, in accordance with DOHMH and CDC guidelines. Contractors must be licensed in New York State as an Article 28 Diagnostic and Treatment Center. The Center(s) used for this contract should be located in high morbidity neighborhood(s).
