PASSPort, the City's digital end-to-end procurement platform, will be an essential hub of information for businesses that have contracts with the City and who wish to do business with the City.

In this note, we are sharing a sneak peek of the PASSPort RFX Portal - a central repository for vendors to see upcoming and open contracting opportunities across the City of New York. "RFX" is a PASSPort term that represents the range of City solicitations, including Requests for Information, Requests for Proposals and Invitations to Bid.

With the RFX Roadmap, you will be able to easily sort business opportunities in a way that makes sense for your organization: by industry, contracting agency, commodity code, program and keyword. All vendors that have a PASSPort account will also receive regular emails containing a digest of new RFX opportunities.
