

# Invitation to Indirect Rate Implementation Briefing

OCTOBER

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In February 2019, the City of New York adopted the Health and Human Services Cost Policies and Procedures Manual to standardize cost allocation practices for health and human service providers contracting with the City. FY20 Adopted Budget established an indirect cost rate funding initiative based on the Manual.

In July, the Office of Management and Budget and Mayor's Office of Contract Services formed a City Implementation Team to design the implementation and roll-out of the new indirect initiative and established a Provider Work Group to advise them. The teams are meeting regularly to develop the framework and mechanics for health and human service provider indirect rate requests.
