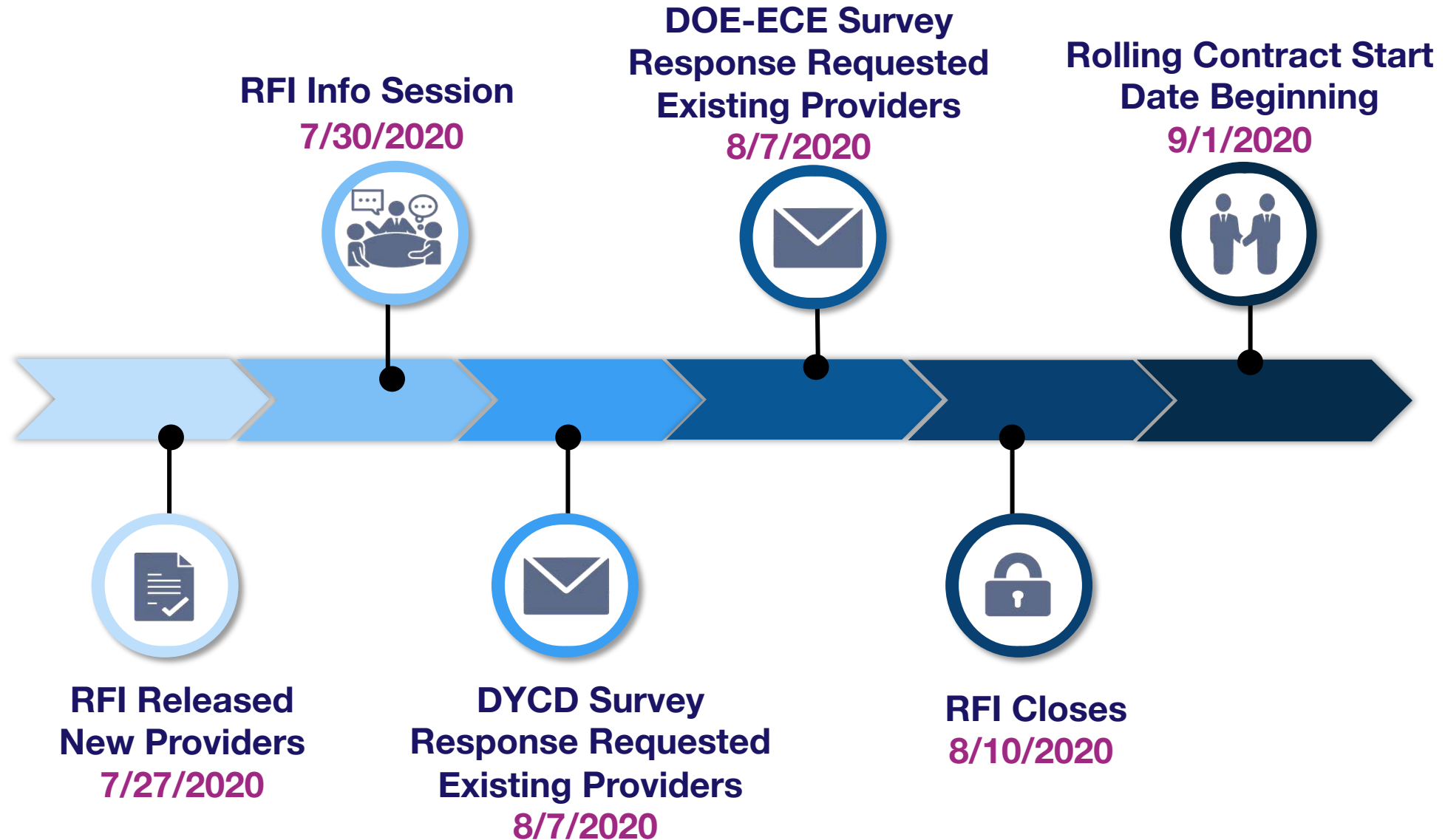

DYCD Learning Labs Information

- **Clients:** Youth in grades K-8
- **Location:** Non-DOE Buildings
- **Days and Hours:** Monday – Friday, 8am – 3pm
- **Rolling Start Dates beginning in September**
- **Rate:** \$7,812/contracted seat/year, pro-rated to contract term
- **Wrap Around Services:** Provide Remote learning and enrichment on days children are not in school
 - Small-group enrichment activities, for example:
 - Literacy, Creative Arts, Physical Fitness, Civic-Engagement, Social-Emotional Supports, and STEAM (science, technology, engineering, arts and math).
 - Youth Development Framework, supporting social-emotional development and the needs of youth experiencing disruption and trauma in these times.
- **Staffing Requirements:**
 - School Age Child Care (SACC)
 - No more than 15 youth/classroom
 - Program Director, Site Safety Monitor, Educational Specialist, Group Leaders/Activity Specialists
- **Applicable Regulations:** Align with Part 414 of section 390 of the NYS Social Service Law and guidance from state and local agencies. (See Interim Child Care Guidance on the NYC DOHMH website)



What early childhood services are we seeking in this RFI and who can apply?

- We are looking for information from potential new early childhood providers on their capacity to provide additional child care services to 3 and 4 year olds.
- This child care will complement the anticipated blending learning that will begin in September 2020 to ensure families have 5 days of full time care.
- Applicants to this RFI **should not** currently hold any existing contract with the DOE for early childhood services.
- Organizations may apply with or without current operating space. Organizations may indicate interest in partnering with another entity to provide space.
- If your site is not currently permitted, you will be required to secure needed permits before serving children. DOE can support you in this process.
- We are seeking providers who can begin services in September, but are also open to sites that may be able to open on a rolling basis through the fall.



What are the requirements to provide this early childhood service?

- ✓ Ability to operate for 6 hours and 20 minutes per day, during typical school day hours, 5 days a week
- ✓ Ability to staff and operate sites in alignment with Article 47 of the NYC Health Code and all recent guidance regarding COVID-19 health and safety measures
- ✓ Ability to provide lunch and snack on site to each child
- ✓ Willingness to partner with the DOE on centralized enrollment and placement of children
- ✓ Willingness to partner with families and the DOE to support remote learning activities and to provide developmentally appropriate activities throughout the day
- ✓ Must be a legal entity able to pass a background check and eligible to do business with the City of New York

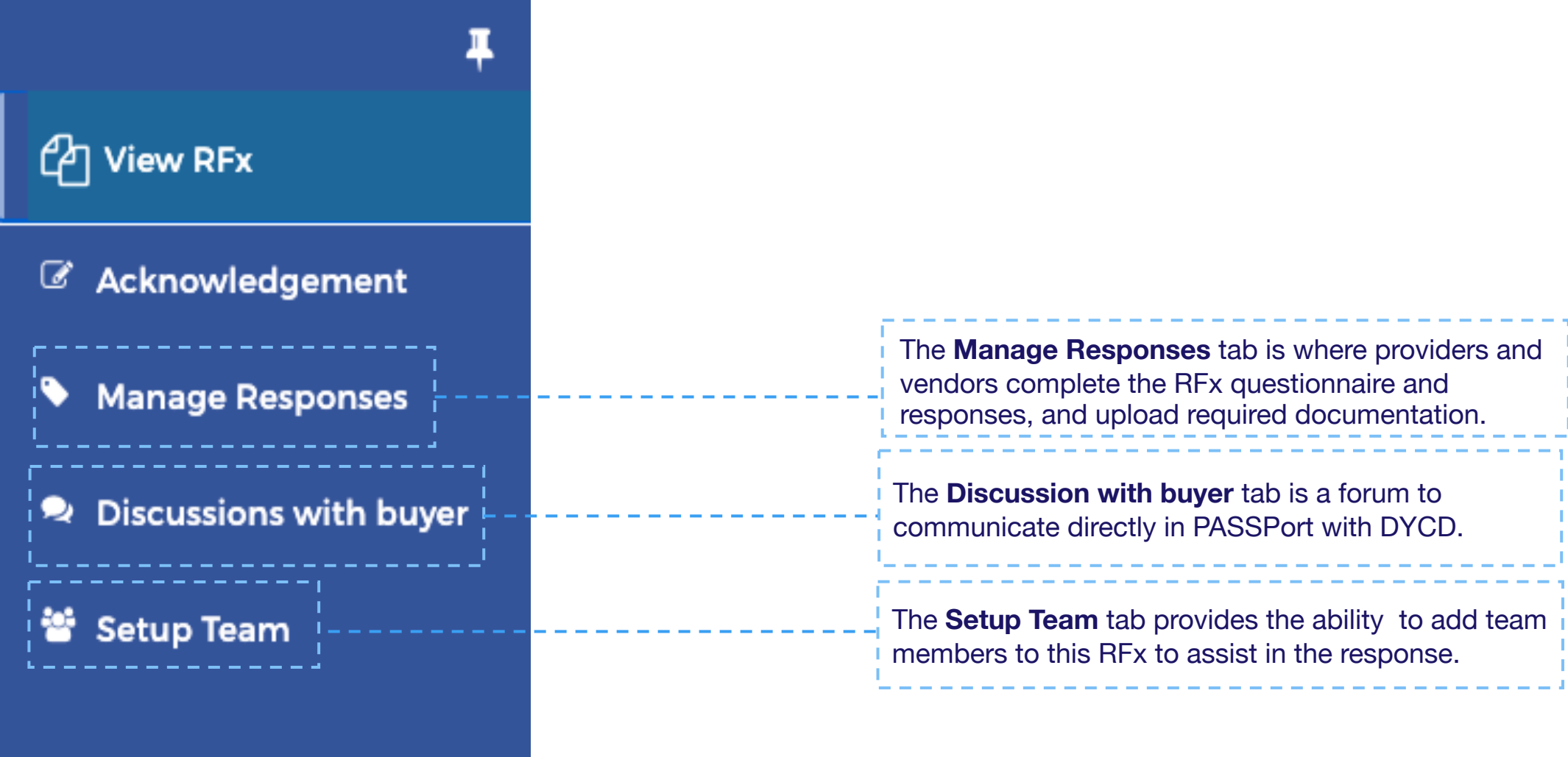
