When does the application period open and what is the deadline?

The application period will be open on May 29, 2019 at 11am and will close once 2,000 applications have been received.

What happens after you submit an application?

Applicants will be invited to an appointment to continue the process of determining eligibility according to the date and time of their application submission. Applicants will be asked to bring documents that verify their household size, identity of members of their household, and their household income. If the developer determines that an applicant is eligible for a unit, NYCHA will contact the applicant regarding Section 8 eligibility and certification.
