

Stability Voucher Program

The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) has awarded a limited number of Stability Vouchers (SV) to the New York City Housing Authority (NYCHA).

SVs are limited to:

- 1) Individuals and families currently experiencing homelessness;
- 2) Individuals and families at risk of homelessness;
- 3) Individuals and families fleeing or attempting to flee domestic violence, dating violence, stalking, sexual assault; and
- 4) Veterans and families that include a veteran family member that meet one of the criteria in 1-3, above.

Families and individuals who may be eligible for SV assistance cannot apply directly to NYCHA for SV assistance. Instead, potentially eligible families and individuals must complete an initial screening and be referred by the New York City Continuum of Care (NYC CoC) or one of their contracted service providers. All clients referred to NYCHA must complete an online SV application for further screening and for SV program eligibility.
