

NEW YORK CITY WATER BOARD

PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT in accordance with the provisions of Section 1045-j (3) of the New York Public Authorities Law, that after public hearings were held on June 1 and June 2, 2021, the New York City Water Board (the “Board”) at its annual meeting held on June 14, 2021, adopted a resolution approving a 2.76% increase to the water and wastewater rates that first went into effect on July 1, 2020, and as reflected in the Board’s Water and Wastewater Rate Schedule (the “Rate Schedule”) effective July 1, 2021. In addition, the Board adopted:

- (1) A freeze of the minimum charge for meter-billed customers at \$0.49 per day for water service, with no change to the additional charge for wastewater, which remains at 159% of water charges.
- (2) A Rate Schedule amendment concerning properties that were automatically enrolled in the Multi-Family Conservation Program (“MCP rate”), stating that the 10% surcharge originally applicable to Fiscal Year 2021 for properties enrolled in the MCP Rate but that did not yet administratively demonstrate compliance with the program’s terms would not be assessed the 10% surcharge during Fiscal Year 2022.
- (3) Amendments to the Comprehensive Water Reuse and Private Wastewater Treatment Plant discounted billing programs, authorizing developments comprised of multiple properties sharing a Water Reuse or Private Wastewater Treatment Plant to apply as a group for the discounted billing rates.
- (4) A restatement of the Board’s statutory billing requirement with respect to late interest charges assessed on overdue water and wastewater bills.
- (5) An amendment to the term of authorized customer wastewater allowances, and an adjustment to the rounding rule used in calculating exceptions to the standard wastewater allowance.
- (6) Other clarifications to existing policies and procedures.
