POLICE OFFICER BRIAN R. JONES

Police Service Area #4



Police Officer Brian R. Jones was shot and killed while attempting to arrest a man for robbing and assaulting another officer's cousin.

On Sunday, October 13th, 1996, at about 10:00 pm, Officer Jones and the officer whose cousin was the victim of the robbery and assault, encountered the suspect at the corner of Miller and Hegeman Avenues in the East New York section of Brooklyn. Both officers were off duty.

When the officers attempted to apprehend the suspect, he drew a revolver and the two officers opened fire. During the gunfight, another suspect, whom the officers did not see, shot Police Officer Jones in the back of the head, killing him.

The original suspect was apprehended after being shot by the officers. The suspect that shot Officer Jones fled.

Police Officer Brian R. Jones had served with the Police Department for four years and was 27 years old. He was survived by his mother, Lucille.
