



2017 KEY HIGHLIGHTS

- There were 26 intimate partner homicides and the New York City Police Department responded to over 108,821 intimate partner related domestic incident reports.

- There were over 62,645 client visits to the New York City Family Justice Centers.
- The New York City Healthy Relationship Academy conducted a total of 743 healthy relationship workshops with 13,074 youth, parents and professional staff participants.
- The OCDV Domestic Violence Training Team conducted 283 trainings for more than 6,655 participants.
- OCDV conducted over 1,300 outreach events to raise awareness about intimate partner violence and the services available in NYC.





New York City Domestic Violence Hotline Calls



Domestic Violence Training Team

- The Training Team staff conducted 283 trainings for more than 6,655 participants.

NYC Healthy Relationship Training Academy

- In 2017, the Academy conducted 678 workshops with 12,125 youth.
- In 2017, the Academy conducted 65 workshops/trainings with 949 parents and professional staff.
- In total, in 2017, the Academy conducted 743 workshops and trainings with 13,074 youth, parents and professional staff.
