

Draft Alteration Map (administrative change)

For actions relating to City Map Amendments, a draft alteration map is needed. A draft alteration map illustrates proposed and existing street right-of-way lines, street treatment lines, dimensions and angles (inside the block), street names, street widths, legal grades and tie-in distances, park lines and dimensions, Block numbers, monuments, Bulkhead and Pierhead lines, etc. If easements or corridors are included in the map, they must be dimensioned. Applicants are required to provide calculations when new blocks are created or existing block dimensions are changed.
