



## ■ **Pedestrian Elevation**

A drawing showing the extent of construction proposed including façade treatments for buildings on the Development Site and buildings adjacent to the development site in either direction, at the level of pedestrian views.

- The drawing should show the construction in plain view and elevation, as well as in cross-section (if necessary for clarity).
- The drawing must be fully dimensioned, show height and bulk, façade treatment of the proposed building, fenestration, lighting, and indicate key distances such as: vertical clearance above street grade, distance to curb, street line, nearest intersecting street, pierhead line or shore line, as applicable.
- Existing buildings adjacent to the Development Site should be shown with full façade details.
