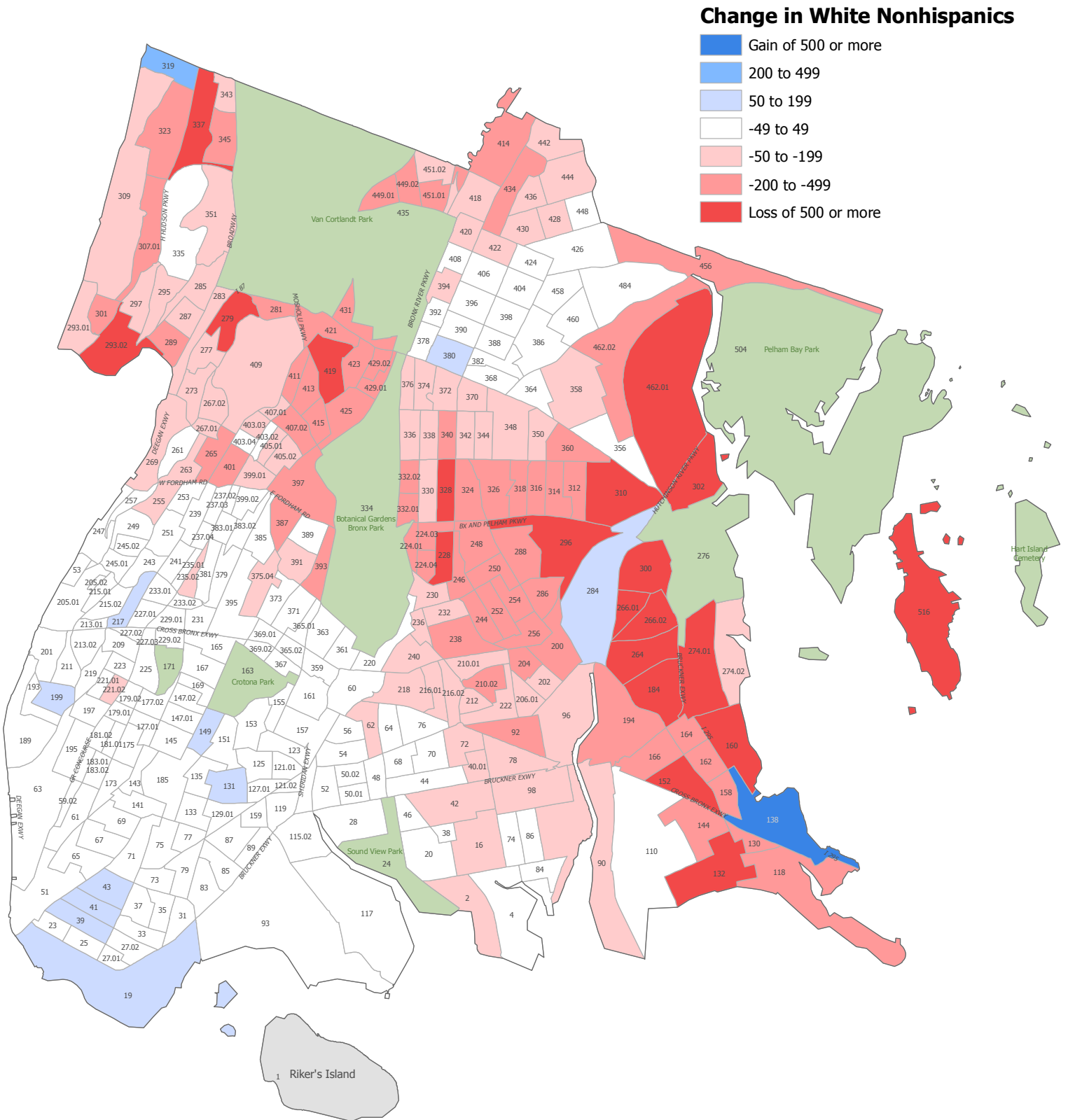


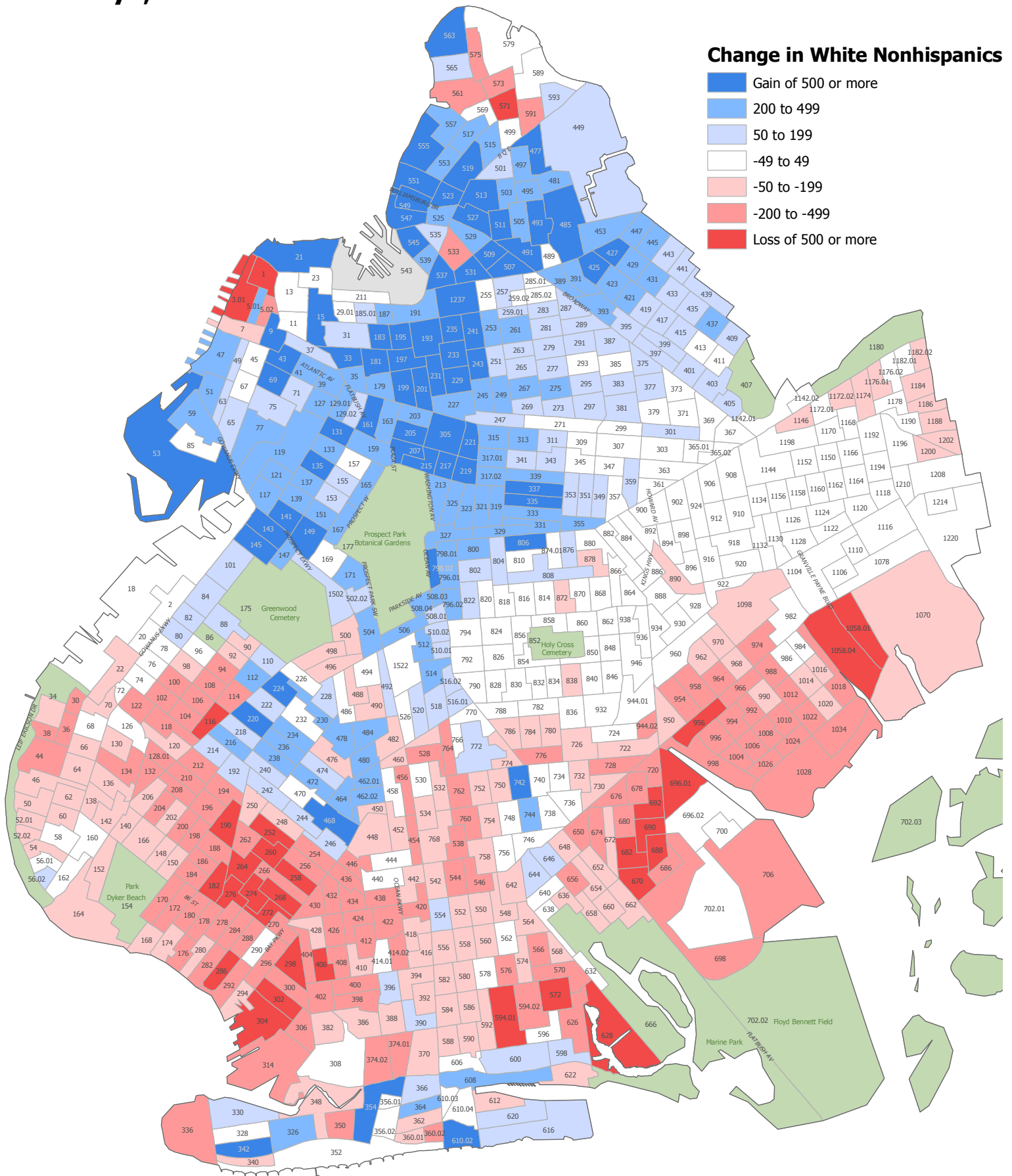
PL-P6 CT: Change in the White Nonhispanic Population by Census Tract Bronx, 2000 to 2010

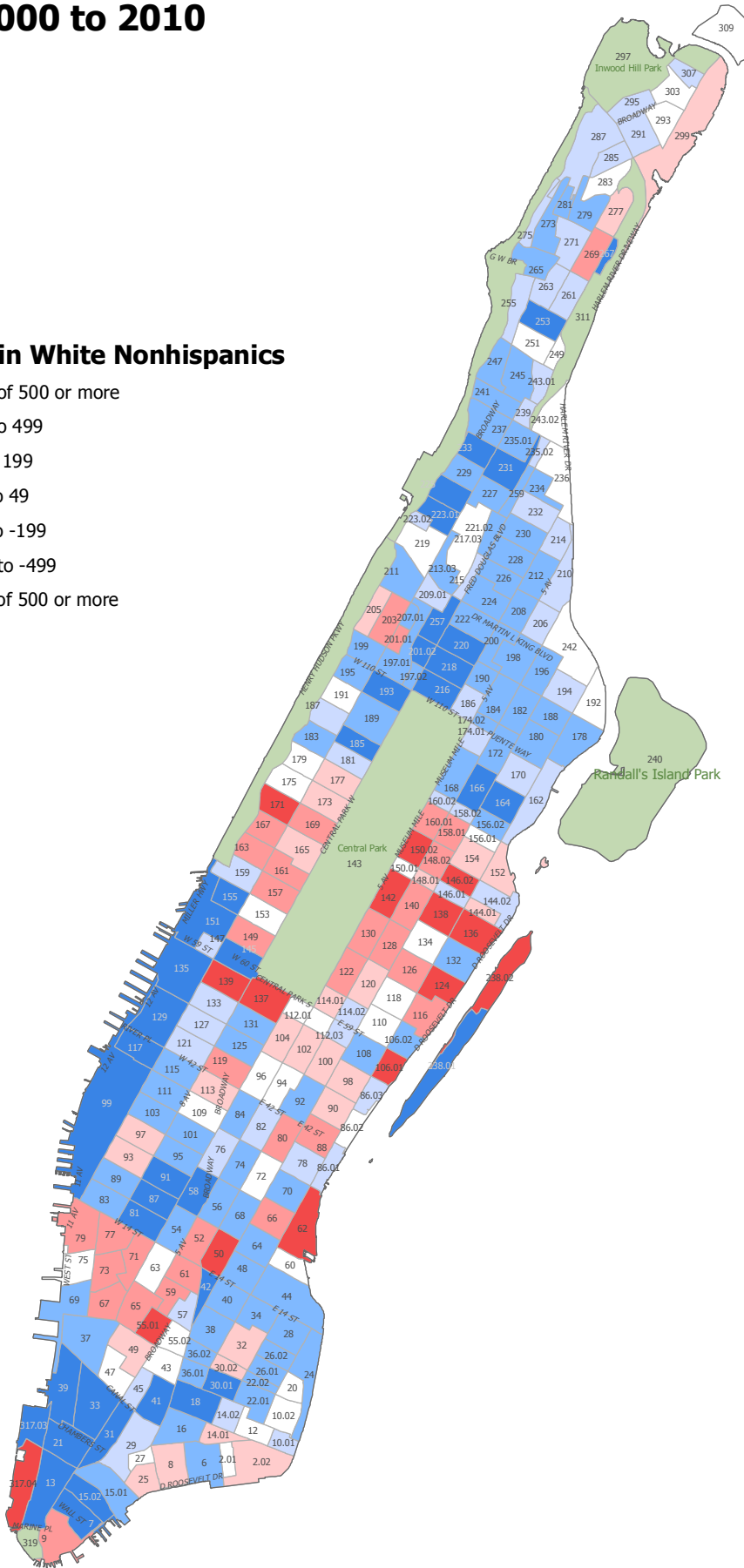
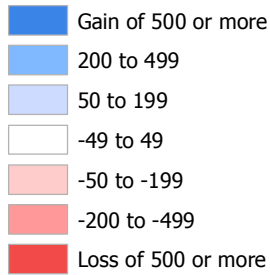

PL-P6 CT: Change in the White Nonhispanic Population by Census Tract Manhattan, 2000 to 2010

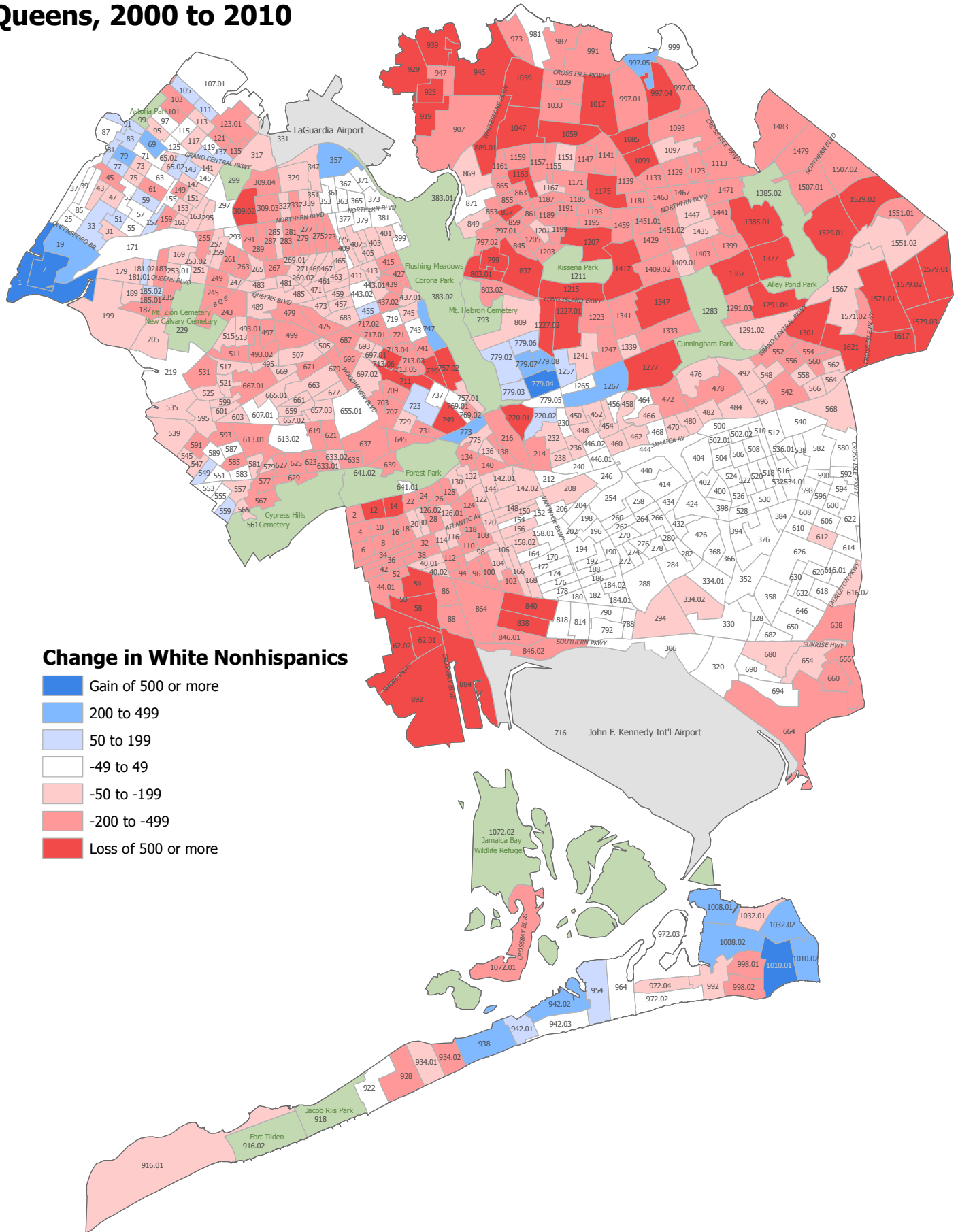

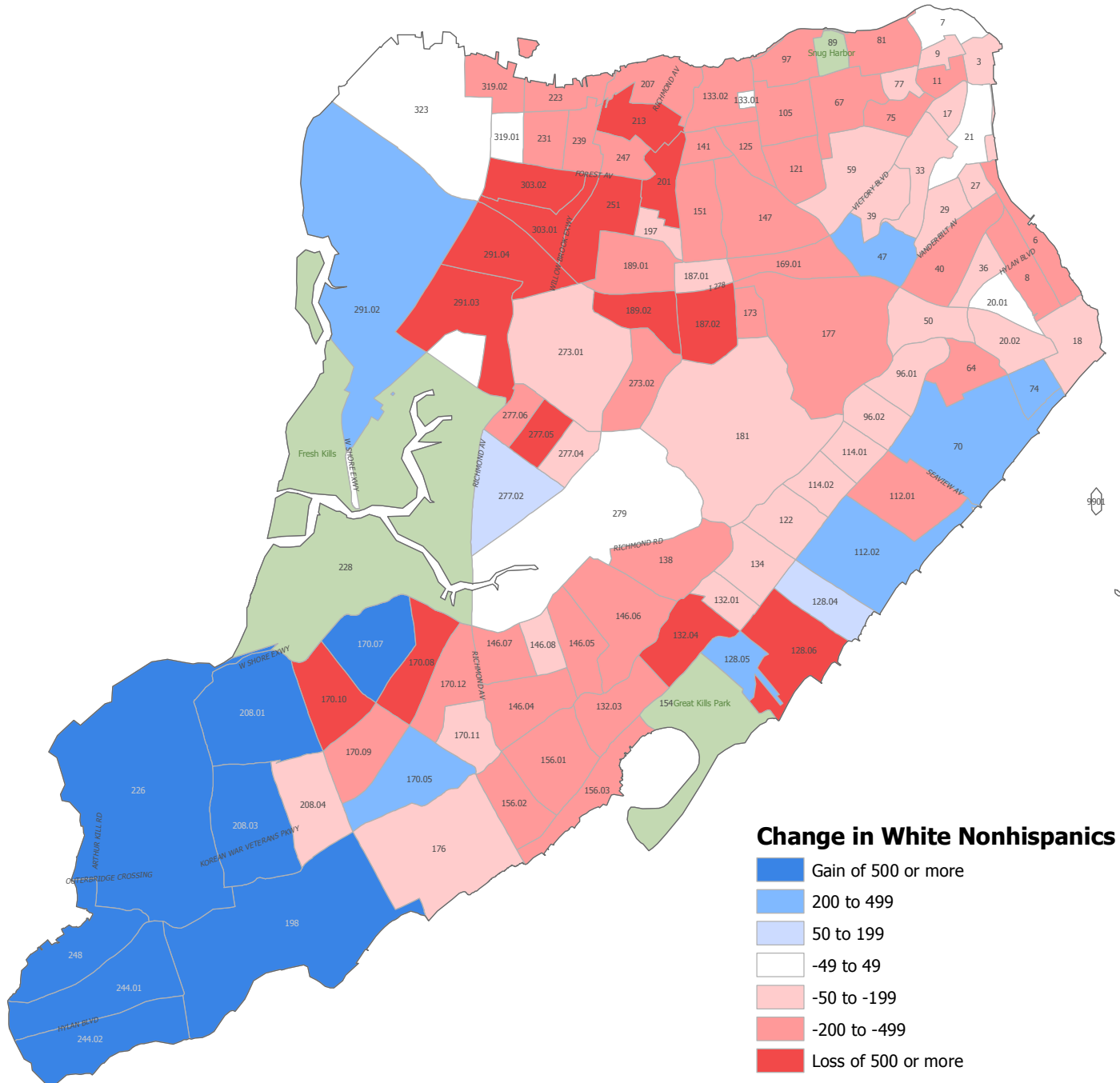
PL-P6 CT: Change in the White Nonhispanic Population by Census Tract Queens, 2000 to 2010
