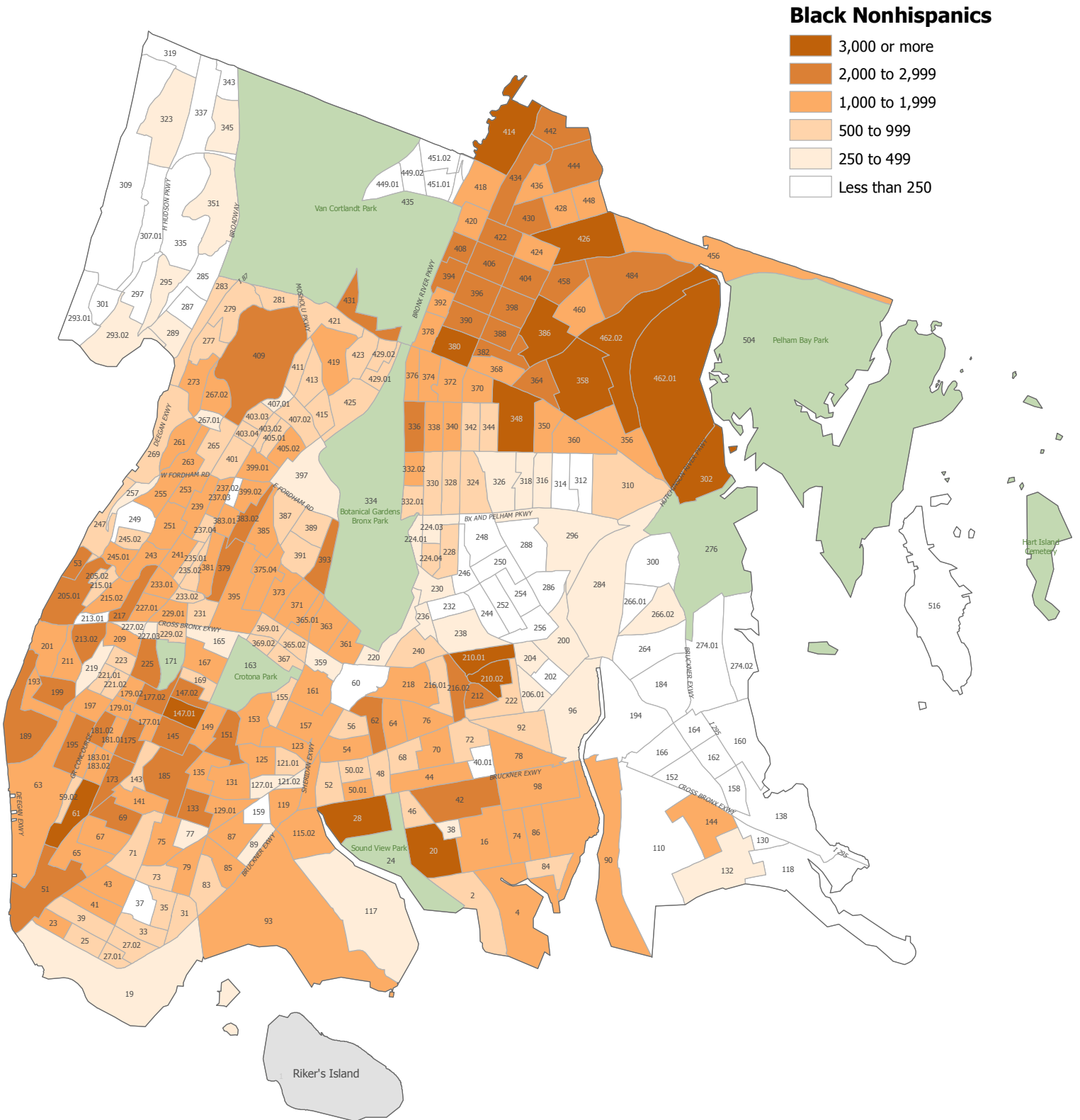
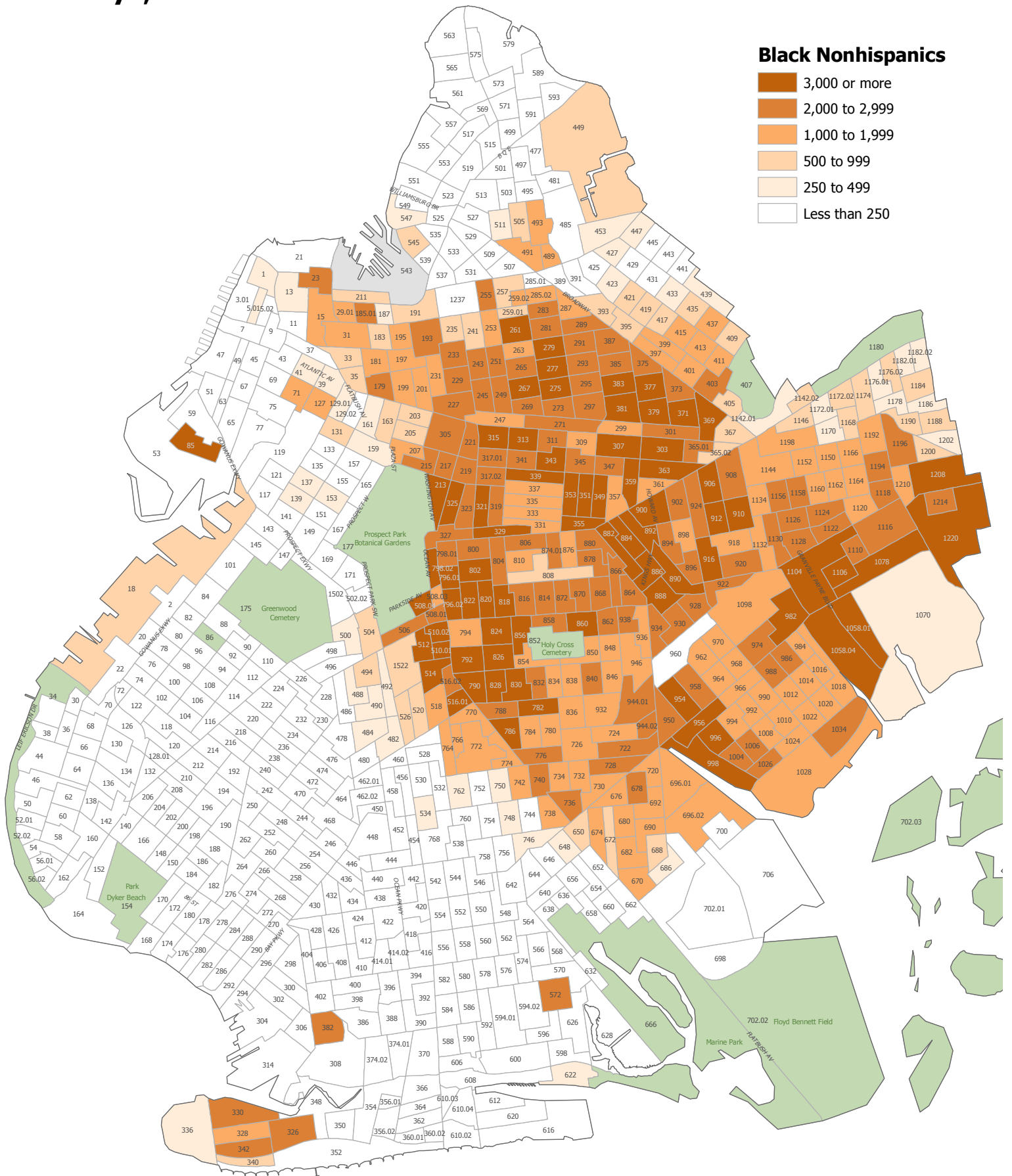


# PL-P7 CT: Black Nonhispanic Population by Census Tract Bronx, 2010

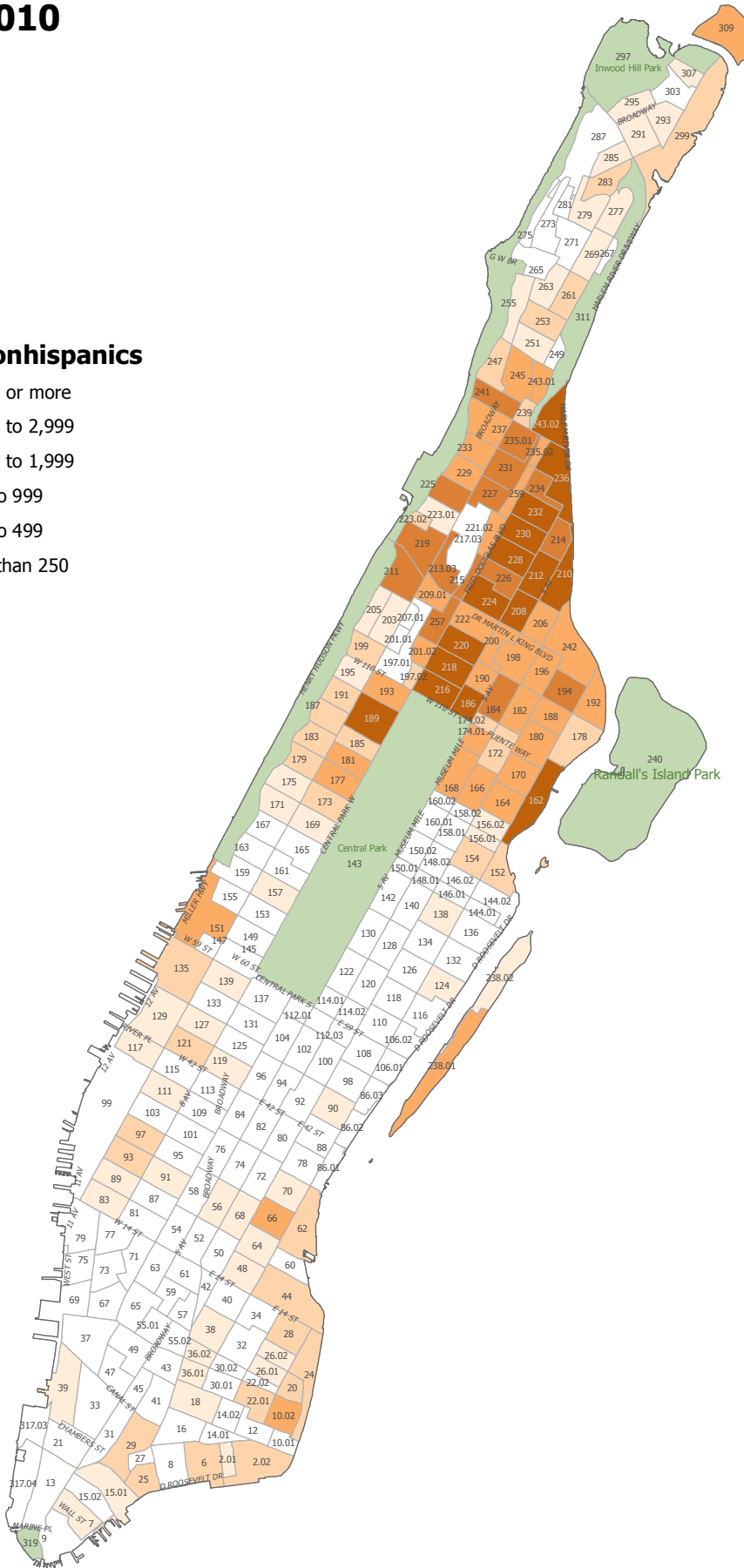
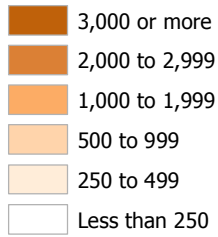

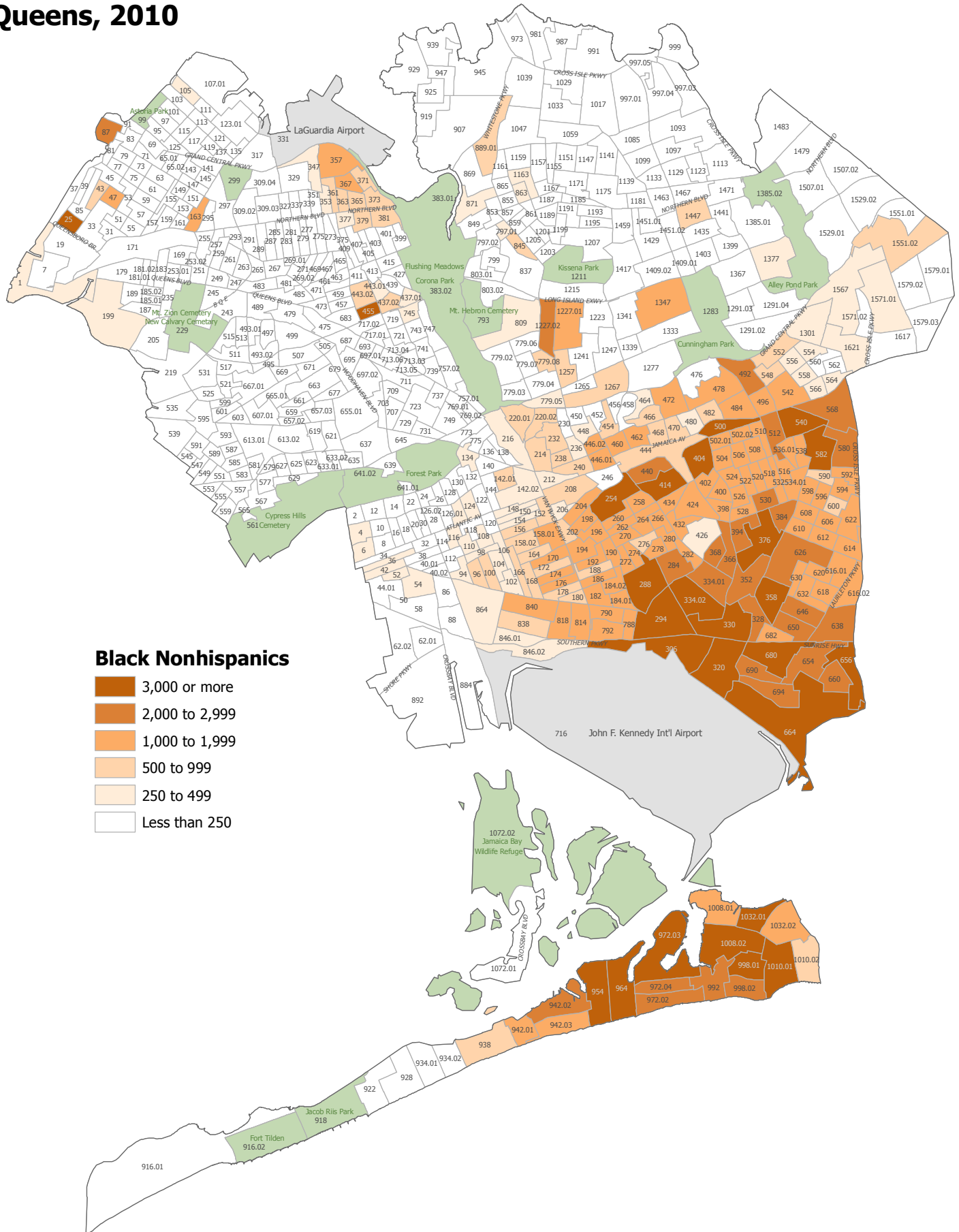

# PL-P7 CT: Black Nonhispanic Population by Census Tract Queens, 2010



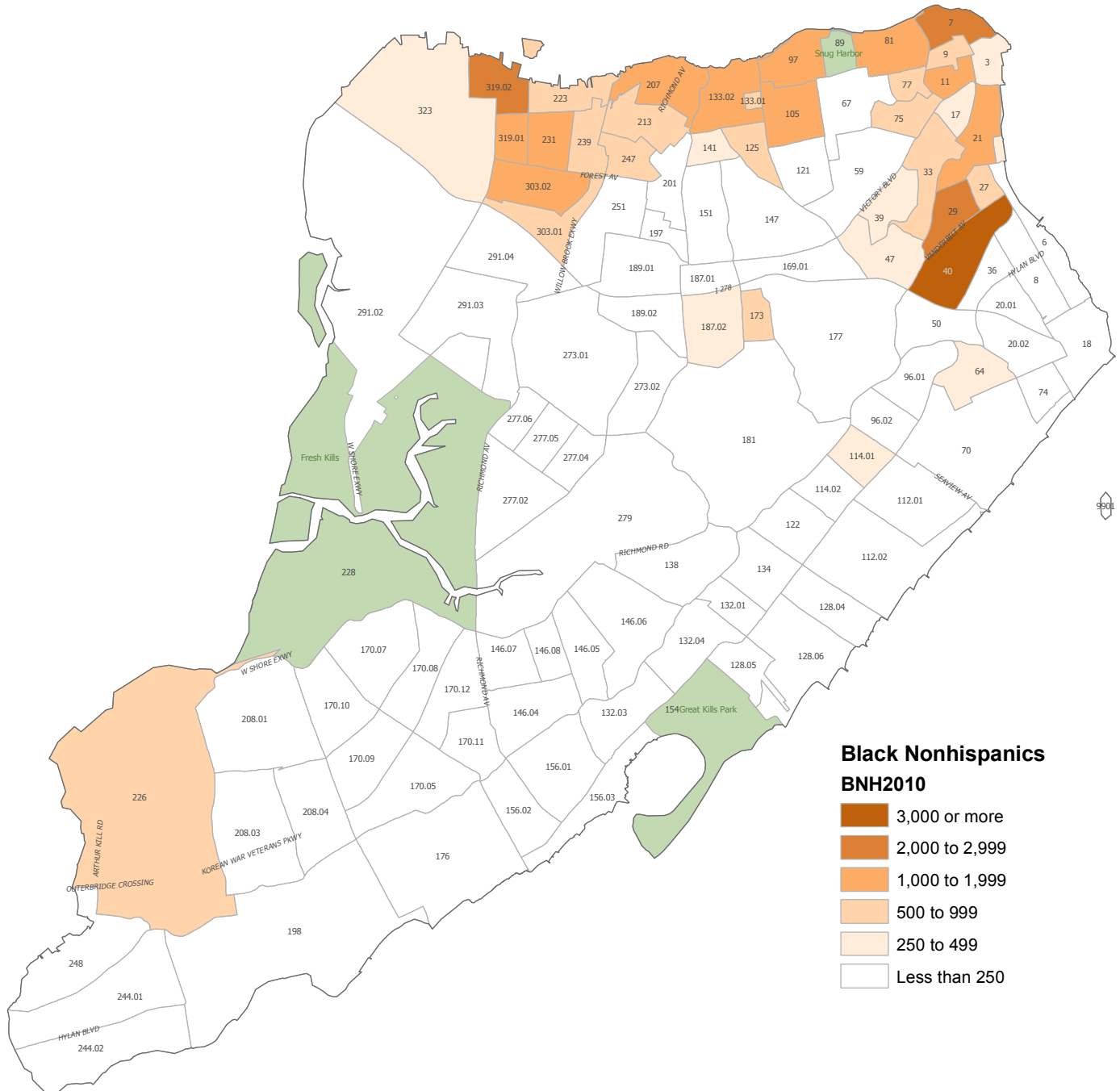
