Enroll in DEP Water Bill with Autopay.

Now through November 15, 2023, DEP customers can receive \$100 off their water bill by enrolling in Autopay. Autopay allows customers to pay their bill automatically on the due dates, you will get monthly notices that your payment is scheduled and paid. Department of Housing Preservation and Development (HPD) Programs in place to assist owners of properties that are in foreclosure. HPD works with the

Center for New York City Neighborhoods (the center) and local community-based organizations to assist homeowners who are at risk of displacement due to foreclosures, scams, municipal tax, liens, operating and maintenance costs, or a lack of estate planning through the Homeowner Help Desk. From April 2022 through March 2022 the program was a pilot program in Central Brooklyn, Southeast Queens, and the North Bronx. Due to the success of the pilot, HPD and the Center are expanding the Homeowner Help Desk model citywide. The program will provide a one stop shop for all NYC homeowners to receive support on a range of issues, including foreclosure prevention, flood resiliency, estate planning and deed theft. The Help Desk will connect homeowners with local community-based organizations to obtain one on one housing financial, and legal counseling.
