Fair Fares

Fair Fares NYC is a City program that offers eligible New Yorkers, regardless of immigration status, a 50% discount on subway and eligible bus fares or Access-A-Ride paratransit trips.

Fair Fares is open to all eligible New Yorkers aged 18-64, at or below the Federal Poverty Level without discounted transportation from the MTA or the City. Fair Fares enrollment assistance is also available at the NYC Asylum Seeker Resource Navigation Center.
