

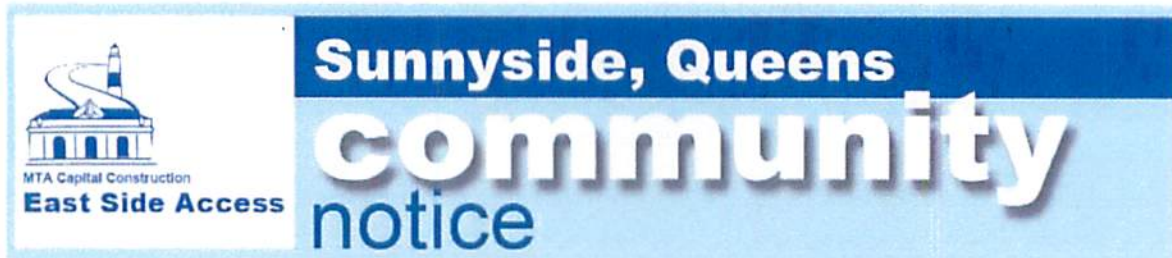

Dear Sunnyside Resident:

In support of the ongoing work to install new tracks and infrastructure along the right of way between 43rd and 48th Streets; the contractor will stage a large crane on 37th Avenue that will be used to set a new switch at track level.

What to expect:

37th Avenue between 43rd and 48th Streets will be closed to vehicular traffic beginning at approximately 12 a.m. on Saturday, September 15th and continuing until 12 a.m. on Sunday, September 16th as permitted by the Department of Transportation.

All possible efforts to minimize and limit the potential effects on the surrounding area will continue to be implemented, however, residents in close proximity, may see lights and hear noise from these activities. The contractor has been directed to aim lights away from residential areas as long as it does not impact the safe execution of this work or operations of trains as they travel past. All work is being performed in conformance with the established safety standards and current regulations for noise, dust and surface vibration.

ESA Community Outreach aims to provide the most up to date information on work activities; **however the schedule of work is subject to change.**
