Chairperson Louis Walker opened the meeting at 7:15 p.m

The subject matter was read into the record:

IN THE MATTER OF A request by the NYC School Construction Authority (SCA) to facilitate construction of

I. S. 311, located at 97-11 44 Avenue, Corona, N. Y.

The School Construction Authority is seeking to have 140 feet of the street closed for a period of four months.

There will be no access to the street and jersey barriers will be in place.

The street closure is necessary to enclose the exterior of the building.

The Chair announced the Public Hearing would not take place since the School Construction Authority withdrew its request.

Attendance was not taken.

At this point, Chairperson Walker reported the SCA no longer needed to have the street closed full-time. The street would be closed on a part time basis instead of completely closed. It is not necessary to seek Board approval to do this.
